- No alcoholic beverages permitted on site. No private golf carts permitted.
- Gas only for cooking

- All food must be cooked on site. Minimum of **15 gallons** of stew must be made.
- Contestants provide own tables, tent (vertical coverage is required), chairs, and bread (must be pre-packaged). Food-grade hoses are required.
- Stew areas must be neat and attractive at all times. Decorations are encouraged!
- Electricity (limited) is available, please see entry form.
- Sales may begin at 11:00 a.m. Samples for judging will be taken at 11:00 a.m. Announcement of winners will be at 1:00 p.m.
- Crews may pack up and leave after 2:00 p.m. Vehicle access to space will be permitted.
