- Member may submit only one entry per class.
- There will be an overall winning chapter, this will be awarded based on total points from each category.
- There will be a public vote to select a “People’s Choice Award” for best overall project.

**Competition components:**

- Project – Projects may be completed using any tools/machines available, including plasma CNC table, CNC mill machines etc.
- Plans – Participants are required to submit plans with their entries including bill of materials. Plans may be hand drawn or digitally made.
- Project card – To be displayed with project – must include participant name, FFA Chapter, FFA advisor, hours to construct, and total cost. Participant may also include information relating to selling the project if they wish.

Class distinctions – all size classes will be based on foot print size of the project. Each project may only be entered in one class.
