OPEN SHOW

Breeding Beef Showmanship to follow. (Peewee, Junior, Intermediate, Senior)

New 2019 Rules

1. This division is subject to the General Rules and these Division Rules.
2. No FOR SALE signs will be permitted in barns.
3. No substitution or refund of entry fees will be allowed for exhibitors because of failing grades making exhibitor ineligible to show their entry. No refunds for any reason
4. Classes will be set according to the number of entries per breed at the discretion of the livestock chairman.
5. **Eligibility**
 - a. The Breeding Beef Division is open to all active 4-H and FFA members enrolled in home, public, private, elementary or secondary schools.
 - b. Animals owned by partnership can be exhibited as long as all parties are enrolled in home, public, private, elementary or secondary schools in Liberty, Chambers counties at the time of show and exhibitor must have owned, fed, and cared for animal.
6. **Entry Information**
 - a. Entries must be entered online on/or before September deadline.
 - b. Late entries will not be accepted after Sept. 15th 2019.
 - c. Each entry must be accompanied by \$20.00 entry fee per animal and a COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS at time of entry
 - d. **All breeding beef registration papers MUST be submitted at time of entry**
 - e. Crossbred animals must have letter verifying age and breed.
 - f. Classification by birth date will be based on the age of animal on date of show.
 - g. NO BULL SHOW
7. **Check-in Times:**
 - a. Early arrival/check in Monday– 11:00 am - 3:00 p.m.- No cattle will be accepted after 3:00 pm
 - b. Regular arrival/check in Wednesday– 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.- All must be in place by 3:00
 - c. Breeding Beef final check in 8:00 am – 3:00 pm
 - d. **OUT OF COUNTY ONLY-Arrival/Check in Saturday 6:30- 7:30 am. Must be in place by 7:30 am**
8. **Judging**
 - a. All animals in this division must be halter broken and trained to lead. Unruly animals will be disqualified.
 - b. All exhibitors must wear an exhibitor number while showing.
 - c. All animals must be shown in the show ring by owner. Substitution – See General Rule #12.
 - d. No substitutions will be allowed for showmanship.
 - e. This is a blow and go show, no fitting
9. **Showmanship**
 - a. Showmanship contest will start following Breeding Beef Show. Jr. 8-12, Int. 13-15 and Sr. 16-18
 - b. Show order will be Peewee, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior exhibitors.
 - c. See General Rule #6 for ages.
 - d. **Exhibitors MUST show in age division of the showman (age on day of show). Any exhibitor found during/after show to have participated in wrong division whether knowingly or accidentally will be disqualified and shall forfeit any/all award(s) given.**
10. **Release**
 - a. Any exhibitor removing animal(s) before release time posted above will forfeit premium(s) with no recourse.
 - b. Release of animals will be Saturday 10:00-4:00- No release after 4:00. Sunday will be alternative day to release if not out by 4:00. Must be out by 11:00 am Sunday.
