

Continued Receipt

1. Funds for the Scholarship will be handled by Trinity Valley Exposition (TVE) and will be sent directly to the college or university the recipient will attend on behalf of the recipient. It is imperative that the recipient notify TVE of acceptance by their chosen college or university and meet the requirements specified in the TVE Livestock Show and Rodeo Scholarship policies.
2. Continued Receipt of Scholarship Funds: A scholarship recipient will be entitled to the continued receipt of scholarship funds so long as the recipient complies with ALL of the following requirements:
 - a. Attend a fully accredited college, university or accredited technical school.
 - b. Enroll and complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester.
 - The lump sum money awarded to the applicant will be divided out equally over 8 semesters.
 - Deadline for applicant to request money for **Fall Semester** – October 1st and **Spring Semester** – February 1st.
 - c. Complete two (2) semester each academic year unless otherwise approved in writing and accepted in advance by TVE.
 - d. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.50.
 - e. In order to request funds, email a transcript and an outside scholarship donor form provided by each institution (please see attached sample) to info@tvefair.com with "Attention Scholarship Committee" for the subject line.
3. Recipient must request money from TVE one year from the date it is initially awarded. However, each request shall not exceed the established deadlines: October 1st for Fall semester and February 1st for Spring semester. Recipient must make at least one request each school year. If money is not requested within these guidelines, it will be forfeited.
4. If you are on pace to graduate early (in less than 8 semesters), on your last semester of the year you are graduating, you can receive the remaining balance that is in the trust on your behalf with a letter from the school stating that you will be graduating early.
5. It is the obligation of each scholarship recipient to comply with these rules. If you fail to comply, you will not be considered a qualified recipient and may lose your scholarship funding.
