Special Preparations: Cut Flowers only for Classes A-R. The Fair Association supplies containers for cut flowers. The exhibitor need not have grown items used in arrangements. Growing Plants only for Classes S-U.

JUNIOR FLOWER SHOW AND WILD FLOWERS AGE 16 AND UNDER

All Junior Class are identical to Adult Class, but are labeled with double letters (e.g., Class A becomes Class AA, Class B becomes Class BB, etc.) Junior Flower Show is NOT divided into Subclass.

Class A ----- Aster & Chrysanthemums

- Lot 1 Giant (large double), 3 blossoms
- Lot 2 Standard, 3 blossoms
- Lot 3 Dwarfs (not daisy), 6 blossoms
- Lot 4 Daisy, standard variety, 6 blossoms
- Lot 5 Daisy, dwarf variety, 6 blossoms

Class B ----- Bachelor Buttons, Dianthus, & Phlox

- Lot 1 Bachelor Buttons (Centaura/Cornflowers) 6 blossoms
- Lot 2 Dianthus, double (Carnations), 6 blossoms.
- Lot 3 Dianthus, single, 6 stems
- Lot 4 Phlox, tall, 3 stems/clusters
- Lot 5 Phlox, dwarf, 3 stems/clusters

Class C ----- Border & Rock Plants

- Lot 1 Ageratum (Floss Flower), 3 clusters
- Lot 2 Alyssum, 3 clusters
- Lot 3 Forget-Me-Not, 3 clusters
- Lot 4 Lobelia, (border/trailing), 6 sprays
- Lot 5 Godetia, Clarkia, 3 stem/spikes
- Lot 6 Verbena, 6 sprays/clusters
- Lot 7 Other, 6 blossoms, 3 sprays/clusters

Class D ----- Dahlias & Zinnias

- Lot 1 Dahlias, giant over 10" 1 blossom
- Lot 2 Dahlias, standard, 3 blossoms under 8"
- Lot 3 Dahlias, dwarf, 3 blossoms
- Lot 4 Zinnias, giant, 3 blossoms

- Lot 5 Zinnias, standard, 3 blossoms
- Lot 6 Zinnias, dwarf, 6 blossoms
- Lot 7 Dinner Plate Dahlias 8-10" diameter

Class E ----- Spikes & Stalks

- Lot 1 Delphinium, giant, 1 spike
- Lot 2 Delphinium, standard/dwarf, 3 spikes
- Lot 3 Foxglove, Lupine, Larkspur, 3 spikes
- Lot 4 Snapdragons, tall, same/mixed, 3 spikes
- Lot 5 Snapdragons, dwarf, same/mixed, 6 spikes
- Lot 6 Stocks, 3 spikes
- Lot 7 Gladiolus, tall, 1 spike
- Lot 8 Gladiolus, dwarf, 1 spike
- Lot 9 Other, 3 spikes
- Lot 10 Other stalks, 1 each

Class F ---- Everlastings & Others for Drying

- Lot 1 Statice, 3 clusters/spikes
- Lot 2 Strawflower, 3 blossoms
- Lot 3 Gypsophila, (Baby's Breath), 3 stems
- Lot 4 Other, 6 blossoms, 3 clusters/spikes

Class G ----- Marigolds

- Lot 1 Standard (African/American), 3 blossoms
- Lot 2 Dwarf (French), 3 blossoms
- Lot 3 Signet, 3 blossoms

Class H ----- Pansies

- Lot 1 Single color, 6 blossoms
- Lot 2 Multi-colored, 6 blossoms
- Lot 3 Viola or Johnny Jump-up, 6 blossoms

Class I ----- Petunias

- Lot 1 Single color, 3 sprays
- Lot 2 Multi-colored, 3 sprays
- Lot 3 Doubles, 3 sprays

Class J ----- Flowering Vines

- Lot 1 Sweet pea, single color, 6 spike
- Lot 2 Sweet pea, multicolored, 6 spikes
- Lot 3 Nasturtiums, 6 blossoms
- Lot 4 Other, 5 stems/blossoms or 3 sprays

Class K ----- Roses

- All foliage and thorns removed from stems to the first bud, cluster, or flower.
- Lot 1 Hybrid tea (long-stemmed, single blossom), 3 stems
 - Lot 2 Grandiflora (lacy multi-flowered stems), 3 stems
 - Lot 3 Miniature (includes Miniflora), 3 stems
 - Lot 4 Wild & perennial (Sitka, Tundra, Rugosa), 3 stems

Class L ----- Lilies

- All foliage removed from stem.
- Lot 1 Asiatic hybrids, 1 stem
 - Lot 2 Day lilies, 1 stem
 - Lot 3 Other, 1 stem

Class M ----- Sunflowers

- Lot 1 Dwarf, 3 blossoms
- Lot 2 Mammoth, 1 flower
- Lot 3 Rudbeckia, 3 blossoms
- Lot 4 Other sunflower-type, 3 blossoms

Class N ----- Miscellaneous

- Lot 1 Calendula, 6 blossoms
- Lot 2 Columbine, 6 stems
- Lot 3 Cosmos, 6 blossoms
- Lot 4 Ice plant, Portulaca, Livingston Daisy, 6 blossoms
- Lot 5 Impatiens, Balsam & Periwinkle, 6 blossoms
- Lot 6 Nemesia, 3 clusters
- Lot 7 Nicotiana, 3 stalks
- Lot 8 Poppies, 6 blossoms
- Lot 9 Trollius, 3 blossoms

- Lot 10 Cut foliage, one variety, 3 stems
- Lot 11 Other flower not listed, 3 stems
- Lot 12 Begonias
- Lot 13 Geraniums

Class O ----- General Garden Display

- Lot 1 Largest number of different varieties
- Lot 2 Best collection
- Lot 3 Best bloom in your garden

Class P ----- Fresh Arrangements

- Lot 1 Cut fresh
- Lot 2 Miniature arrangement (not more than 5" in any dimension)
- Lot 3 Arrangement in unusual container

Class Q ----- Dried Arrangements

- Lot 1 Exhibit book (20-specimen minimum)
- Lot 2 Single specimen, mounted
- Lot 3 Multiple specimens, mounted
- Lot 4 Dried flower arrangement
- Lot 5 Dried wildflower arrangement
- Lot 6 Arrangement in unusual container
- Lot 7 Miniature dried arrangement

Class R ----- Wildflowers

- Lot 1 Fresh cut wildflower, single variety, and 3 stems
- Lot 2 Fresh cut wildflowers, arrangement
- Lot 3 Wildflower arrangement in unusual container
- Lot 4 Miniature arrangement, not more than 5" any dimension

POTTED PLANTS

Class S ----- Outdoor Planters/Pots

- Lot 1 Hanging Baskets, one or more varieties
- Lot 2 Planters/pots; one variety (includes ornamental kale, potted roses)
- Lot 3 Planters/pots, two or more varieties
- Lot 4 Geranium
- Lot 5 Begonia
- Lot 6 Creative Design

Class T ----- Indoor Potted Plants, Flowering

- Lot 1 African violet
- Lot 2 Orchids
- Lot 3 Miniature roses
- Lot 4 Other

Class U ----- Indoor Potted Plants, Foliage

Lot 1 Cacti

Lot 2 Succulents

Lot 3 Coleus

Class V ----- Professional

This Class is for adult professional exhibitors, or who have taught a horticulture or floral design Class. Not eligible for awards, other than Professional Award.
