Class I ----- Fly Tying

Class J ----- Decorative Arts

These items are purchased, and then decorated by the exhibitor. "Batik" items should be entered in Division 10 – Spinning & Weaving. Machine sewn embellished items should be entered in Div. 9.

- Lot 1 Painted clothing– freehand
- Lot 2 Painted clothing– stencil, transfer, paint around
- Lot 3 Embellished clothing
- Lot 4 Painted / Embellished Wood Items – Flat or dimensional.
- Lot 5 Painted/embellished cloth items (non-clothing)
- Lot 6 Painted/embellished indoor items (boxes, baskets, vases, etc.)

- Lot 7 Painted/embellished outdoor items (flowerpots, birdhouses, etc.)
- Lot 8 Painted, dyed, or embellished eggs (must include protective display)
- Lot 9 Painted/embellished frames/album covers/books
- Lot 10 Other

Class K ----- Nature Inspired Art

These are crafts using items from nature – dried grasses, flowers, driftwood, rock, shells, seed, sand, food items, etc. Non-Nature Dioramas should be entered Division 15 – Hobby Show. Vegetable Dioramas should be entered in Division 3B – Novelty Vegetables.

- Lot 2 Candles (must contain or include natural materials)
- Lot 3 Dioramas/scenes/models (Primarily natural materials)
- Lot 4 Homemade potpourri
- Lot 5 Soap – carved

Class L ----- Paper Craft

These items are made primarily from paper

- Lot 1 Paper Mache sculpture (includes masks)
- Lot 2 Decoupage/lamination
- Lot 3 Stationary/cards/gift-wrap – 3 max
- Lot 4 Folded papers (boxes, origami, flowers, etc.)
- Lot 5 Marbled paper – single sheet, flat
- Lot 6 Frames/album covers/books
- Lot 7 Paper Collage – flat or 3D
- Lot 8 Picture from cut/torn paper shapes
- Lot 9 Homemade paper (no natural materials)
- Lot 10 Other

Class M ----- Fiber Craft

Items in this Class may be from purchased forms, decorated/covered with cloth, felt, yarn, thread or other fibers.

Woven baskets and rugs, dyed fiber, tie-dyed and batik items should be entered in Division 10 – Spinning & Weaving. Non-quilted items sewn primarily by hand or machine should be entered in Division 9 – Sewing. Quilted items should be entered to Division 24A – Quilt Show/ Division 24B – Quilted Wall Art.

- Lot 1 Frames, books, and album covers
- Lot 2 Baskets/boxes – decorated or covered
- Lot 3 Cloth made baskets/boxes - includes coiled (no machine sewing)
- Lot 4 Macramé
- Lot 5 Wall hangings/banners (not sewn or quilted)
- Lot 6 Household articles – hooked, latched, tufted (no rugs)
- Lot 7 Other household articles - not hooked, latched, or tufted
- Lot 8 String art
- Lot 9 Rugs – not woven or sewn
- Lot 10 Yarn - not crochet, knit, or hooked (no kits)
- Lot 11 No-Sew fleece items
- Lot 12 Duct-Tape
- Lot 13 Other fiber art projects

Class N ----- Cosmetics

- Lot 1 Homemade soap (must be in container or display)
- Lot 2 Lip gloss
- Lot 3 Bath salts/bath fizzes
- Lot 4 Other

Class O ----- Holiday Decorations

- Lot 1 Ornaments
- Lot 2 Wreaths/wall hangings
- Lot 3 Center pieces
- Lot 4 Foam – flat, shaped, dimensional (holiday themed)
- Lot 5 Other holiday items from fiber (not quilted)
- Lot 6 Other holiday items from any materials (not fiber)
- Lot 7 Holiday themed Cards (3-5)

Class P ----- Scrapbooks

Albums contain primarily photos and may have minimal or limited detailing. Albums will be judged. Scrapbooks contain photos displayed with significant embellishment. Judges will consider esthetic effect and presentation of all entries.

- Lot 1 Album – trip themed
- Lot 2 Scrapbook – “personal” type theme (e.g. wedding, baby, child, etc.)
- Lot 3 Scrapbook –trip or subject theme
- Lot 4 Scrapbook – folded, dimensional
- Lot 5 Scrapbook – sample pages, Maximum of 3 pages, single or double sided; not in a book.

Class QQ -----Pre-Formed Materials (Jr only)

Items in this Class are made from purchased materials. The item used for most of your construction will be the Lot entered. Enter Kiln-fired items in Division 25 – Ceramics & Pottery. Enter sun catchers/dream catchers in Division 14- Alaskan Native Arts.

- Lot 1 Popsicle sticks, matchsticks, toothpicks
- Lot 2 Plaster or resin-type items, figurines, etc., decorated (not kiln fired)
- Lot 3 Pipe cleaners, pompoms and straws
- Lot 4 Foam – flat, shapes, dimensional, Styrofoam (not from a kit and not holiday themed)
- Lot 5 Lacing/lanyards
- Lot 6 Bead/sequins
- Lot 7 Plastic beads – fused
- Lot 8 Gel window clings
- Lot 9 Magnets
- Lot 10 Combinations of 2 to 3 different materials
- Lot 11 Combinations of 4 or more different materials

Class RR ----- Kits (Junior Only)

Items are made from craft kits but may have some additional embellishments added. Paint-by-Number and Puzzle-type assembly wood items should be entered in Division 15 – Hobby Show.

- Lot 1 Foam – flat, shapes, dimensional, Styrofoam (not holiday themed)
- Lot 2 Mosaics
- Lot 3 Bead art (not fused/melted/baked)
- Lot 4 Wood items
- Lot 5 Stained plastic – painted
- Lot 6 Stained plastic – melted/baked
- Lot 7 Other kits not specified above
