SPECIAL AWARDS People's Choice Rosette

Special Preparations: Maximum size for ALL exhibits (except those in Class G) is 12" x 20" x 12". **Maximum size for Class F (including Lego's) is 12" x 12" x 12"**. Due to limited space, the Fair is unable to display every entry if some entries are larger than these. If the exhibit is larger than the sizes listed above, contact the Superintendent prior to entry day. Hanging exhibits must be prepared for hanging before being entered. All collections must be affixed to a board, in a container, or in a display case. Gem/mineral collections may be displayed in bags that are stapled, taped, or glued to the board. **Clay is not to be used to affix any items to a board.** Due to space limitations, it is often necessary to display boards at an angle and clay does not adequately hold items to a board. When using tape, make sure that all areas of the tape are covered so that it will not stick to other items.

Collections may be limited to one page or up to 5 items of overall collection, depending on space availability. Entries of great value will be judged but may not be displayed if locked exhibit space is not available. Judging will be based on 1) quality rather than quantity; 2) originality; 3) attractiveness of display; and 4) on the items in the collection. Individual items in the collection need not be made by the exhibitor.

Please include a 3" x 5" card explaining your entry. Contact the superintendent for more information. Although many items will not include a display background, some, such as collection, will be partially judged on how they are displayed.

JUNIOR HOBBY SHOW AGE 16 AND UNDER
