## SPECIAL AWARD People's Choice Rosette

#### QUILTS over 40 inches wide without Velcro sewn on back will not be accepted.

**Special Preparations:** Enough Velcro needs to be sewn onto the top edge of the back of any quilt over 40 inches wide so it will be held securely on our rack. Use the "hook" side of the Velcro. The easiest way to attach the Velcro is to machine stitch top and bottom to a piece of fabric. Then whip stitch the top and bottom edges of the fabric, to the back of the quilt just below the binding. Note: Stick-back Velcro will not work!

**Condition:** Entries must be clean (no pet hair, quilting marks, soil, or unpleasant odor) and have a new appearance.

#### **Definition:**

- <u>Maker</u>: the creator of the quilt top: If more than one person made any portion of the top, the quilt belongs in Class G Made by a Group
- <u>Longarm or midarm</u>: Any machine mounted on a frame allowing the quilter to move the machine rather than the fabric
- <u>*Home sewing machine:*</u> Any sewing machine that is table-mounted or stationary which allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than move the machine.
- <u>Edge-to-Edge Quilting:</u> A continuous line design quilted from one side to the other side and repeated from top to bottom of the quilt.
- <u>Custom Quilting:</u> Individual quilting designs in borders, sashing, blocks and/or in the body of the quilt, as with Whole Cloth Quilts.

## Class A -- Large – Edge to Edge by Longarm/Midarm Machine

- Freehand or edge to edge pantograph is quilted on Longarm or Midarm machine
- Lot 1 Pieced Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 2 Applique Applique predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 3 Mixed/Other Whole cloth, photo, embroidery, crazy, etc. or even amounts of applique and piecing.

## Class B ------ Medium – Edge to Edge by Longarm/Midarm Machine

- Measures 250" 324" around the entire quilt
- Freehand or edge to edge pantograph is quilted on Longarm or Midarm machine
- Lot 1 Pieced Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 2 Applique Applique predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 3 Mixed/Other Whole cloth, photo, embroidery, crazy, etc. or even amounts of applique and piecing.

# Class C -- Small – Edge to Edge by Longarm/Midarm Machine

- Measures under 250" around the entire quilt
- Freehand or edge to edge pantograph is quilted on Longarm or Midarm machine
- Lot 1 Pieced Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 2 Applique Applique predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- Lot 3 Mixed/Other Whole cloth, photo, embroidery, crazy, etc. or even amounts of applique and piecing.

#### Class D -- Quilted by Hand, or Home Sewing Machine

- Quilted by hand or on home sewing machine (no Longarm or Midarm quilting.
- Lot 1 280" or more around the entire quilt
- Lot 2 Less than 280" around the entire quilt

#### Class E ----- Custom Quilted by Machine

- Individual designs are custom quilted using a Longarm, Midarm or home sewing machine
- Lot 1 280" or more around the entire quilt
- Lot 2 Less than 280" around the entire quilt

## Class F----- Miscellaneous Coverings

- This class includes all sizes
- This class includes coverings such at comforters, puffed or tied quilts
- Lot 1 All Quilts

#### Class G ----- Group Project

- A group fair ID is required for this Class
- Quilt top made by two or more people
- Includes all sizes and quilting method
- A top or set of blocks acquired (purchase, gift, block exchange, "found", etc) by an individual or group and then finished into a quilt
- Lot 1 All Quilts

## Class H ----- Wall Quilts

- Intended for display on a wall
- All quilting methods are allowed (i.e., longarm, midarm, home sewing machine or by hand)
- Refer to lots under Class D
- Lot 1 280" or more around the entire quilt
- Lot 2 Less than 280" around the entire quilt

#### Class AA ----- Junior - Large Quilts

- 200" or larger around the entire quilt
- Lot 1 Single maker, quilted
- Lot 2 Single maker, tied

- Lot 3 Single maker, quilted by adult
- Lot 4 Group (Quilt top made by more than one junior)

#### Class BB -----Junior-Small Quilts

- Smaller than 200" around the entire quilt
- Lot 1 Single maker, quilted
- Lot 2 Single maker, tied
- Lot 3 Single maker, quilted by adult
- Lot 4 Group (Quilt top made by more than one junior)

## **Division 24B** Quilted Wall Art

**Special Preparations:** Due to the limited space, exhibits are limited in size approximately 160" total around. Entries must be easy to hang on metal crossed wire panels using large metal clips. **All ornamental wall hangings are to be original (no kits),** made of fiber, and quilted. The work is to be done and quilted by one person or club. **Judging** will be based on: Technique- complexity, difficulty; Design – overall presentation, color choices, with a strong emphasis on Originality.

**Definitions:** 

**<u>Ouilted</u>:** stitched, fastened, or sewn layers with padding in between (at least 3 layers). <u>Fiber:</u> Material made of fine threadlike filaments such as cotton, plastic, jute, metal, nylon, etc.
