SPECIAL RULES

- A. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations and to the Special Rules of this department.
- B. Exhibitors must be able to exhibit the animal by themselves.
- C. Enter Gate 6/H.
- D. All Lambs must be accompanied by a current (within 30 days) Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued by a certified veterinarian.
- E. Each exhibitor will be restricted to three entries in any single class. No exhibitor will be permitted to win more than two places in any one class.
- F. Sheep that are not entered in the show will not be permitted on the grounds.
- G. Bedding will be available for sale at the livestock office or you may bring your own. **No straw or hay will be allowed in the stalls.**
- H. NO ANIMAL WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS WITHOUT PROPER RELEASE.
- I. This division is open to any youth (not over the age of 19).
- J. All lambs must be carrying all milk teeth at the time of entry into the show ring. Lambs showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
- K. Upon arrival each exhibitor must obtain from the Superintendent a packet containing their lambs' weight/breed cards for their entries in this division.
- L. Exhibitors will be responsible for weighing their own lambs and must return weight cards to Superintendent by 7:00 PM Friday, September 6th. Any entry whose weight card is not received by this deadline will be disqualified. ***Fine Wool, Fine Wool Cross and Medium Wool lambs weighing less than 85 lbs. will not be eligible to compete. Minimum weight on Southdown's will be 70 lbs.*** Scales will be provided.
- M. Exhibitors must indicate on weight card the breed of each entry. All lambs will be classified at the time of judging. If the animal is classified out, it will be disqualified in that class and moved to the proper class.
- N. After weight cards have been returned to the Superintendent, entries will be divided into groups as equally as possible by classification. There will be three (3) Fine Wool classes, three (3) Fine Wool Crossbred classes, three (3) Southdown classes, and five (5) Medium Wool classes. Weight classes may be changed, if needed, at the discretion of

- the Superintendent. Any lamb not meeting minimum weight requirements, or lambs with weight more than 3 lbs. above the upper limit for that weight class, will be disqualified and not be allowed to show in another class.
- O. All lambs must be slick shorn from knee and hock at time of arrival. No electric clippers or shearing will be allowed. Violators will be disqualified from the show and removed from the grounds. Blocking tables and blowers are acceptable.
- P. No paint, powder, or artificial coloring may be used on lambs.
- Q. Ewes and wethers may be shown.
- R. Premiums will be paid to 8th place and animals will be placed to 10th place for TCL points.
- S. Entries must be made online and may be completed by the exhibitor.
