SPECIAL RULES

- A. All entries in this department are subject to the General Rules and Regulations, the Junior Livestock Show Rules, and the Special Rules of this department.
- B. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection current, within 30 (thirty) days is required and must be presented upon arrival at the gate to be allowed onto the grounds.
- C. There will be no prior claiming of stalls, all entries will be pre-stalled. You must designate whom you wish to stall with on instructor's summary sheet. Stall requests are for whom you would like to be stalled with, not the area of the barn. Groups will not be split and are stalled by chapter. If no choice is indicated, show management will designate stalling. Pavilion stalling will be on a first come, first serve basis; that preference needs to be indicated on entry forms. Stall requests are due August 15, 2019.
- D. To be eligible to exhibit in the 2019 Junior Steer Show, all animals must be tagged with an official TX Steer Tag approved by the TX Education Agency Department of Agricultural Education and the TX AgriLife Extension Service. Steers must be validated in the month of June 2019, with a nose print attached to the complete validation form to be filed in the respective District Extension Agent's or Area Vocational Agriculture Supervisor's office. The validation number on the official Texas Steer Tag must be shown at check-in time.
- E. Each Exhibitor is entitled to enter two steers in the Steer Show. The steers may be purebred, high grade or crossbred. The steers must have been owned by the exhibitor prior to June 30, 2019. Exhibitors must have continuously personally fed and cared for their entry under the direct supervision of a County Extension Agent or Vocational Agriculture Teacher from July 1, 2019 to the opening date of the show.
- F. Steers will be weighed, sifted and classified on Friday, Sept. 13 at 9:00 AM. Steers will be weighed by breed groups. The sifting committee appointed by the Fair will pass on all steers entering the Show. All unworthy animals will be refused the privilege of competing for prizes and will be removed from the Fair Grounds, as it is intended that only animals that are credible from standpoints of type, quality and finish shall be entered or shown.

- G. Upon weigh-in, steers will be divided into 2 divisions:
 - Division 1: PROGRESS STEERS - Over 1000 lbs.**
 - 3 Breed Groups: English, American & European. Classes determined after all steers have been weighed.
 - Division 2: PROSPECT STEERS - 700-1000 lbs.**
 - 17 Breed Classification system will be used. Classes will be determined after all steers have been weighed.
- H. Parents will not be allowed to assist exhibitors in the show ring. Parents, County Agents and Voc./Ag. Teachers will be permitted to assist in lining up the steers, but must stay out of the ring when the Judge begins work.
- I. No grooming material is allowed. This is a "Blow and Go" Show. All steers will be shown with hair in a natural state WITHOUT the use of glues, adhesives, paints, etc. Steers with any type of glue, paint, adhesive, etc. in the hair will be disqualified and premiums forfeited. Steers will be toweled.
- J. One trimming chute for each FFA Chapter and County 4-H Group. Chutes will be placed in designated trim chute alleys. NO FLOOR FANS OR PORT-A-COOLERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE LIVESTOCK BARN. Fans to be hung from above are allowed and 1 FAN PER ANIMAL.
- K. Any steer which cannot be handled by the exhibitor during the judging will be removed from the ring.
- L. Any substitutions will be made at the scales.
- M. A showmanship class will be held after the Grand and Reserve Champion Steers have been selected by a committee and will be announced prior to the selection of the Overall Champions.
- N. Only steers entered in the show may be brought onto the grounds. Show superintendent and management will determine the consequences for violation of this rule.
- O. Please have your VEHICLE and TRAILER license plate number available when picking up release form.
