SUBJECT: Texas Fairs and Events Education Foundation \$2000 Scholarship

Applicants must:

1. Read the scholarship requirements.
2. **Provide** all information on the two-page application.
3. Answer all questions and supply all supporting data. Failure to do so will result in disqualification/consideration for scholarship award.
4. Sign the application.
5. Be a U.S. citizen.
6. Mail application materials in one envelope to ensure receipt of all information. Special folders and presentation materials are not needed and are not viewed by the scholarship committee.
7. Submit a **one-page essay** as to why you deserve a scholarship.
8. Have participated actively in a fair or event that is a current member of TAF&E.
9. Rank in the upper 33% of his/her class.
10. Furnish official transcript of his/her high school record. The college entrance scores, size of class and rank in the class should be entered on this transcript and the transcript should include data through mid-year of the applicant's senior school year.
11. Provide a recent photograph or clear snapshot to the Foundation office with application.
12. Furnish a letter of recommendation from his/her high school principal that addresses applicant's general qualifications and character.
13. Be a graduate from a Texas high school during the year of application and attend a college or a university the following fall and spring semesters.
14. Attend an accredited college or university and enroll for and complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester. A GPA of 2.50 is required to receive the second and final scholarship installment.
15. Receive scholarship payments (if chosen) as scheduled by the Foundation. Please make other arrangements if receipt of Foundation scholarship payment conflicts with other scholarships, grants or financial aid received.
16. If chosen, the student assumes the main responsibility of communication with the TAF&E office and must supply a valid email address and phone number to be reached while in college.

3. Principal's letter*
4. High school transcript*
5. One page essay

*Please do not mail separately. Letter and transcript may be sealed by school if school requires.

Additional Information

The following information needs to be typed on a separate sheet(s) of paper:

- History of participation in Texas Fairs and Events - include year, name of fair/competition event, and place won (1st, 2nd, etc.).
- School activities, honors, club memberships and competitions other than Fairs or Events.
- List other scholarships and awards you know you will receive including the name of the scholarship and the amount awarded.
