



Agricultural Exhibitor Camping at the Eastern States Exposition:

We hope that you are thinking of joining us as an exhibitor for this year's Eastern States Exposition. We want to do everything we can to make sure your time with us is an enjoyable experience. During the Fair several of our camping areas have reached maximum capacity and because our camper staff gives an amazing effort to accommodate all requests we want to make sure that your arrival here to the grounds does not create an unnecessary bad experience.

May we remind you of some of the rules that are in place and present to you some of the new additions for 2018, added for the exhibitor's ease of set-up.

There are no reserved spots. All camping reservations are accepted with the understanding that you are requesting a spot. Camper credentials will be mailed when entries are made and payment received. All camper lot spots will be assigned as you arrive by the camping supervisor, Chuck Perry in Livestock Show and Gary Saccocia in Horse Show. They will not assign a spot unless you have the proper credentials displayed on the left front side of the unit.

In order for us to insure that all exhibitors are treated with respect regarding their requested time with us: Campers should arrive on the dates suggested for arrival in the prize lists and premium book. Campers should also leave when the show is over and not be left. As there may be a need to double- park in areas, dates on the credentials need to be correct to avoid unnecessary movement of a unit. All tow vehicles and personal autos need to be removed to designated parking lots.

Because we all will be close neighbors in the camper lot we ask that you respect each other by abiding by these simple campground rules:

- 1. No awnings extended.
- 2. All generators must use up stacks
- 3. Only grounded electrical cords maybe used. Extra drain hoses and splitters may be necessary
- 4. Gray or black water must not be drained onto the ground. Failure to follow this rule may result in loss of camper spot.

We encourage socializing and enjoying your fellow exhibitors but please remember we all aren't on the same schedule. **Quiet time is 12 am – 6 am**.

We look forward to your time here at the Eastern States Exposition and we hope that you will follow these simple rules and help us make your stay pleasant and memorable.
