ENTRIES CLOSE AUGUST 15

Late entries close August 31 and entry fee is double the standard fee.

SPECIAL RULES

- 1. READ GENERAL RULES.** All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY.** All animals entered in the Angus Show are subject to the provisions of a rule of the American Angus Association, "Eligibility, Conformation and Structure of Animals presented for Exhibition," effective June 16, 1985. All animals must be born before June 1, 2020, including animals for Cow-Calf.
- 3. IDENTIFICATION.** All eligible animals must have a legible tattoo to participate in this show.
- 4. PREMIER BREEDER.** Awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals bred by him/her and shown in the individual classes.
 - PREMIER EXHIBITOR.** Awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals (not to exceed 10) exhibited by him/her in individual classes.
 - POINT TABULATION.** The highest amount of points allowed per class will equal one less than the number of animals in the class (10 shown first gets 9 points, 2nd gets 8 etc.)
 - a. Class with only one animal will not receive any points.
 - b. Points will be given for Divisional Champions & Reserve Champions – equaling the number of classes represented (Cow-Calf and Steer are considered a division), i.e., 3 classes = 3 points for Division Champion, 2 points for Reserve.
 - c. No points for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female or Bull or group classes.
 - d. Animals owned jointly will be considered a separate exhibitor in Premier Exhibitor tabulations. Leased animals will be considered an entry of the Lessee.
 - e. To be eligible for Premier Breeder the breeder must be an exhibitor in the current show.
 - f. In the event of a tie the number of points shall be divided by the number of animals the points were derived from and the exhibitor/breeder having the higher point average shall be presented the award.

5. HERDSMAN. Eastern States Exposition will award a Herdsman's show stick to the Angus exhibitor showing consideration to fellow exhibitors and Management representing his/her cattle and farm to the public in a positive manner as determined by the Beef Show Superintendent.

6. GROUP ENTRIES. Group classes may be entered on the original entry form or may be entered during check-in, no entry fee required. Each animal must be entered in an Open Show individual class and check in at the ring; exception is the Cow-Calf class.

7. PROOF OF OWNERSHIP. The entry's original registration certificate, online paper or association duplicate (NO PHOTOCOPIES) will be considered as proof of ownership, identity, age and breeder. Ownership listed on the entry must correlate with ownership listed on the registration certificate. Animals under one year of age may show a copy of the registration application statement from the breed association stating animal registration is pending.

8. EXHIBITOR. Exhibitor must be the owner or member of a partnership or syndicate owning the animal. Animals owned in partnership or syndicates must be entered and shown in an individual class of the show under the partnership or syndicate's name. In group classes, partnership or syndicate animals may be entered and exhibited under the name of one of the co-owners, but must be entered in all group classes in the same manner. For the purpose of meeting the requirements in all group classes and for Premier Breeder and Exhibitor, an exhibitor is further defined as those members of an immediate family residing on one farm and where the herd is one unit.

9. SUBSTITUTION. Any entry may be substituted within or between classes after the entry deadline, providing the owner and/or part owner making the original entry is owner and/or part owner of the entry being substituted. A registration number assigned by the breed association and accompanied by a letter from the breed will be acceptable. Substitutions may be made among different members of the same family on the same farm.

10. Fitting in the Open Show is optional. The Big E will not enact or enforce a "no-fit" policy for an Open Show.

11. TIE OUTS. Tie outs will be assigned prior to your arrival.

JUNIOR SPECIAL RULES

1. READ GENERAL RULES. All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY. The Junior Angus Show will be open to any boy or girl born after January 1, 1999 and before January 1, 2015. Membership in 4-H, FFA, or any other agricultural youth organization is not a requirement to show. Animals must be registered in the American Angus Association in the exhibitor's name before August 15, 2020. 4-H leases will be accepted if dated by June 1, 2020. Animals registered in farm, family names, or syndicates are ineligible to show in the Junior Show. Bull calves and Cow-Calf classes must be bred and owned for Junior Recognition.

3. BIRTHDATES. All Junior exhibitors will abide by regulations as to entry, stabling, health, etc. Junior exhibitors may show in the Open Show. An animal entered in a Junior's name and shown in the Junior Show must be shown in that exhibitor's name in the Open Show. Junior shown animals will pull ahead for placing at the conclusion of the class. Junior animals eligible to show in Heifer classes 705-723, Bull classes 728-732 and Cow-Calf classes 701 and 702.

4. SHOWMANSHIP. Showmanship will be comprised of four showmanship classes, Showmanship classes will be determined after entries have been processed. Showmanship participants must be signed up by the end of check-in. Day of Show sign-ups will not be permitted.

5. BRED AND OWNED ANIMALS will be acknowledged by pullout following class placing.

761	Produce of Dam. Two animals, either sex. ET calves accepted. Animals must have been shown in individual classes.	A
762	Best Pair Bred And Owned: Either sex or age, both animals must have shown in individual classes. The exhibitor must be the breeder and first owner of the animals exhibited in individual classes. The breeder and first owner must have the same member code. A cow-calf pair is not eligible for this class.	A
763	Get-Of-Sire: Consisting of three head either sex. Animals must have shown in individual classes.	A
764	Breeder's Herd: Five animals, both sexes represented. The exhibitor must be the breeder and first owner of the animals exhibited in individual classes. The breeder and first owner must have the same member code.	A
765	Best Six Head: All animals must have been shown in their respective single entry class and they must be owned by exhibitor or by a member of his/her immediate family. A cow-calf will be considered as two head if calf was shown individually.
