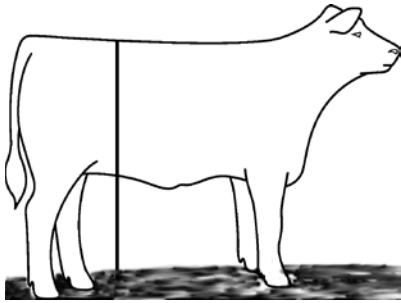

- Corn Silage \$25 - \$35/Ton
- Oats \$100 - \$140/Ton
- Ear Corn \$65 - \$100/Ton
- Pasture (minimum value) \$5/Animal per month
