6. Jars of granola will be displayed during the Fair.
7. Eastern States Exposition and the Creative Arts Staff reserve the right to not display entered items for the entire duration of the fair.
 8. The recipes do not need to be original, but the original source must be listed. Additional points are awarded for original recipes.
