With the help of her two young sons, Jesse and Dylan, Kelleher wrote The Big E Book as a beautifully illustrated guide of the Fair. Timeless features of the Fair, such as the Giant Slide, the Avenue of States and Hallamore Clydesdales in Farm-A-Rama are included in the illustrations.

The idea came to Kelleher when she was exchanging Big E memories with her sons. As someone who attended the Fair with her parents and grandparents growing up, she wanted to recognize all of the memories shared across generations of families who love The Big E. The book includes two interactive pages for the reader to add their own Big E photos and memories.
