Re: BIG E Environmental and Natural Resource CDE

Dear FFA Advisors and Team Members,

I am Tom Hojnowski, advisor of the Canton FFA in Pennsylvania. My daughter, Tricia and I are once again the chairpersons for the event. I wanted to connect with you to let you know that we have printed out the Environmental and Natural Resource Guide 2017 – 2021 from the National FFA web site and are using this as our guide for what areas we will attempt to once again cover in 2018. I anticipate we will add the oral component this year as is shown in the CDE guide. Please be watching for updates as the event draws near via e-mail.

Should a GPS unit be needed, we will have them available or you can bring your own just in case. I am not sure if we will be able to incorporate a gps segment to the event. So, be prepared for what is mentioned in the national guide for that day. Computers will not be needed this year for the event, and if we find we need one, we will supply them. Cell phones are not permitted at all while the event is run, so if we see them, the students will be disqualified.

The scantron sheet found on the national site will not be used as our choices will not fit that format for all. The national soil profile scorecard or something very similar will be used. The Water Analysis and GPS Location scorecards may be used. If you look at the individual expectations for the GPS activities, you will note there are more expectations than what you see on the GPS scorecard. Be prepared for a GPS activity, but I am uncertain if we will be doing one at the Big E.

Please, be patient as we continue to try and make the event as meaningful as possible while trying to maintain an even playing field. Official dress is required. Show off that FFA pride.

Here is what we are anticipating for this year's schedule. Please check back as for more information on the team event. If your team qualifies and you are coming to the event, ADVISORS, please e-mail Tom Hojnowski at thojnowski@canton.k12.pa.us and let me know your school name, state you are from, your name as the advisor and the names of those FFA members whom will be attending. I will be sending specific information about the team event for all who are coming a few weeks prior to the event and requesting the names of the members who will be attending should you have not sent those names by then.
