## **5 Fun Facts About the Big E**

1. The Big E is the world's only multi-state fair, representing all six New England states. It hosts nearly 1.5 million guests for 17 days in September. It all began in 1916!
2. The buildings of Storowton Village Museum date back to the 18th and 19th centuries and were brought here in pieces and then rebuilt. This was the first time in US history buildings were moved in this manner for the purpose of creating a museum.
3. The Coliseum made headlines in 1916 when it broke existing construction records with the completion of all ten great 200-foot steel arches in only ten days.
4. About 2400 chicks are born in Farm-A-Rama's special chick hatchery during the 17 days of the Fair. It is one of the most popular spots for visitors of all ages.
5. Blake Shelton, Diana Ross & The Supremes, Joan Jett, Johnny Cash, Reba McEntire, Willie Nelson and many more have performed at The Big E.
