OLD DOMINION BRINGS HAPPY ENDINGS WORLD TOUR TO THE BIG E IN SEPTEMBER
Tickets on Sale May 10

Old Dominion, one of the hottest breaking bands in Country music, and the 2018 ACM Vocal Group of the Year, brings its Happy Endings World Tour to The Big E's xfinity arena Saturday, September 15 at 7:30pm. Tickets, priced at \$49 and \$39, go on sale Thursday, May 10 at 10am at TheBigE.com and The Big E Box Office.

It all began in high school for lead singer Matthew Ramsey and drummer Whit Sellers, who then met lead guitarist Brad Tursi and bassist Geoff Sprung in college. The group is rounded out by multi-instrumentalist Trevor Rosen, who they all met in Nashville where each had moved to pursue careers as songwriters and session players. Ramsey, Rosen, and Tursi have enjoyed major success writing for such artists as Kenny Chesney, Blake Shelton, Dierks Bentley, Luke Bryan, Keith Urban, Tyler Farr, Sam Hunt and The Band Perry, collectively scoring an impressive string of seven No. 1 hits.

Initially, the band came together to showcase the songs they had been writing for other acts, but they formalized a band in 2007 when they began to gain notoriety playing live gigs.

"We already knew we were hit songwriters because people were recording our songs and making them hits," Rosen said.

Their first hit, "Break Up With Him," became the first single on their 2015 debut album *Meat and Candy*. After going into rotation on SiriusXM's The Highway, the song spent two weeks at No. 1 on *Billboard's* Country Airplay chart. Their latest hit, "Written in the Sand," recently hit No. 1 on the *Billboard* Country Airplay chart and the *Mediabase* Country chart.

Old Dominion is one of the few bands in Nashville that write and play their own songs. The band prefers to create inventive arrangements that are influenced as much by Rock and Pop as by Country. The gold-certified *Meat and Candy* climbed to No. 3 on *Billboard's* Country Albums chart and spawned the gold-certified "Snapback" in addition to "Break Up With Him," which has been certified Platinum.

Old Dominion has been nominated for three ACM Awards (winning Best New Vocal Duo or Group of the Year in 2016), as well as two CMT Awards, an American Music Award, and a 2017 iHeart Radio Music Award.

The band has opened for Kenny Chesney and been on the road with Thomas Rhett and Miranda Lambert, where they kept learning and striving to become the best they can be.
