Paper Plate Rainbow Craft

Part I



1



- Materials:
- Yellow Paint
 - 1 Paper Plate cut in half
 - Cutting board (or scissors)
 - 1 Ruler

- 1 Paintbrush
- Gold glitter
- Bottle of glue
- Construction paper

Use your ruler to measure the width of the construction paper strips. Use your best judgement in making each strip in proportion to the paper plate.

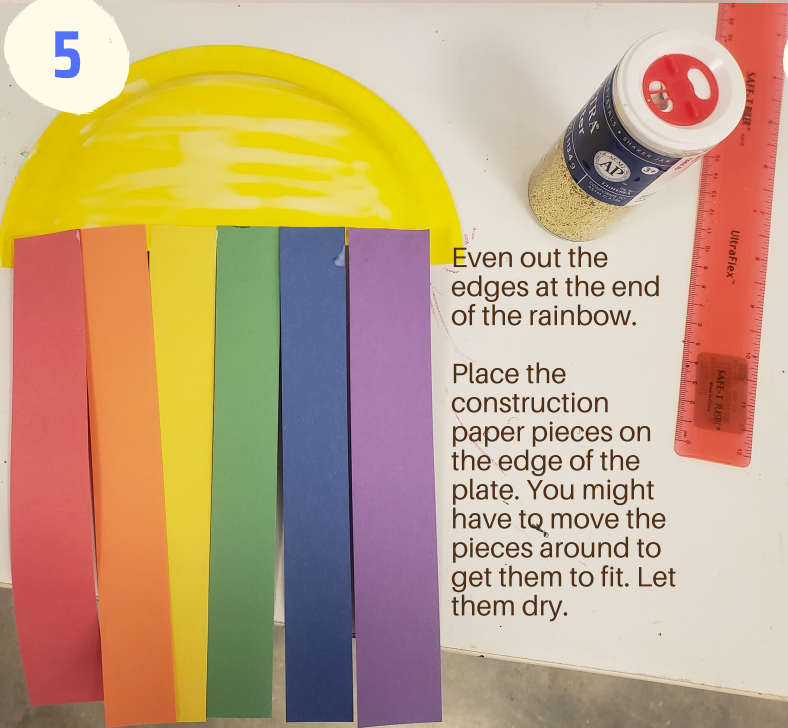
Paint the paper plate half yellow. Allow it to dry for about 5-10 min.

Apply glue onto surface. With your paintbrush, smear the glue all over the plate. Once you're done, wash off the glue from your brush.

Even out the edges at the end of the rainbow.

Place the construction paper pieces on the edge of the plate. You might have to move the pieces around to get them to fit. Let them dry.

6

Use a piece of paper on the back before applying glitter on the plate. It's ok if it gets on the rainbow.

Using yellow construction paper, cut out triangular shapes of any size. Apply with glue and wait for it to dry

Optional:
Add glue to the paper strips and sprinkle glitter on them
