

PARKING AND DELIVERY RULES AND INFORMATION

1. You **MUST** have a Barn Parking Pass to park in the Barn Parking Area and it **MUST** be displayed on the left side of your vehicle dashboard at **ALL** times.
2. Persons with Barn Parking Passes **MUST** follow **ALL** directions of parking lot attendants. Failure to follow parking lot attendant's directions will be reported to the Fair Office.
3. Barn Parking Pass holders will not park in a manner which creates traffic problems.
4. Vehicles loading or unloading feed for animals during the fair may do so between 6 - 8 am. Entry is through the Brookfield gate. Your license number will be recorded by the security guard and you **MUST** leave fairgrounds by 8 am. The driver will be allowed in without an admission or parking pass. Any and all other passengers must have a 4-H/FFA bracelet or admission pass to come onto the fairgrounds at this time. Drivers must remove vehicles from the fairgrounds by 8 am. You **MUST** have a Barn Parking Pass to park in the Barn Parking Area after you have delivered feed.
5. Exhibitors for the Open Dairy Show will be allowed to leave their cattle trailers at the fairgrounds during the fair provided they park them in the Staging Area on the South side of Brookfield Road across from the entrance to the Race Stables. **ALL** cattle trailers **MUST** be parked in that designated area at all times. Please park your cattle trailer as far back in the staging area and in an organized manner. Please don't block the entrance to the staging area at any time. Horse trailers, Pig-N-Ford cars and Demolition Derby cars will also be using the staging area.
6. If you choose to bring your dairy trailer back on Saturday before 7:30 pm to load out your animals, **DO NOT** park it anywhere else on the fairgrounds except for in the Staging Area.

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF RULES

1. Harassment of parking attendants or violation of the rules may result in revocation of Barn Parking Pass.
2. Violations could result in a recommendation that the violator not be issued a Barn Parking Pass the next year.
3. Violations of the rules could result in the violator's vehicle being towed from the fairgrounds.
