<u>Gates and Parking</u>-Gates 1, 5 and 4 are the main visitor entrances to the fair. Gates 1 and 5 are free parking and gate 4 is paid parking with a \$5 fee. Always remember to take or hide all valuables that you may have in your vehicles. The fair is not responsible for break-ins or stolen items.

Fair Admission-Adults \$10, Youth (6-12) \$5, Sr. Citizens (55+) \$5

Fair Hours-Opening Day-Friday, Sept. 13-4PM Saturday and Sunday 8AM-Midnight

<u>ATM</u>-There will be ATM's placed throughout the fair grounds for your convenience. Our fair is cashless at the midway and food court. Entrance gates and food court will take credit cards.

<u>Lose Something?</u>-Yes. Lost and found items from the carnival or any location of the fair are taken to the main office on the south side of the fairgrounds. Gate 2 or call 806-376-7767.

<u>Carnival Hours-</u>Carnival Hours:1 PM-Midnight on the Weekends and 4PM-Midnight during the week.

Height Requirements for Carnival Rides-36" is the minimum with a ticketed adult. All rides have a minimum requirement and those differ with each ride. <u>Mega Passes</u>-Mega Passes are \$75 September 1-Sept. 12. \$95 Sept. 13, Mega Passes include daily gate admission and a carnival wristband each day of the fair.

Mega Passes go on sale at the fair office August 15 and at Toot'n Totum September 1.

## **Prohibited Items-**

The following items will not be allowed at the Tri-State Fair & Rodeo

- Weapons of any kind, knives and fire arms especially
- Controlled Substances
- Any out side food or beverages
- Bicycles, skates, roller blades, skateboards and hover boards
- Animals (except service animals or show animals)
- Any and all items that are deemed dangerous by Safety Inspection Staff or Fair Staff
- Drones

Please leave the above items at home or in your car. If brought to the gates you will be denied entry and asked to take the item back to your car.

## Don't forget!

- Bring a comfortable bag to carry your items in like your phone or wallet.
- If you are coming with a large group create a meeting place so you can always find each other.
- Watch what you leave in your pockets on the fair rides and always check the seats after you get up.
- If you or your child get separated from each other, check with the Police and Medical tent located across from the Bud Light stage or any fairgrounds employee
