Exhibitors are requested to familiarize themselves with the General Rules and Regulations and the Special Rules of this department.

1. **COMPETITION:** Competition is open to the world in all divisions. All competitions are held under the direct supervision of the Tri-State Fair & Rodeo and approved with respective organizations.
2. **RESERVATION:** The Fair reserves the right to refuse entries, accept entries conditionally, consolidate, or cancel classes, change classes and stall assignments without claim for damages.
3. **STALLS/BEDDING:** Wood shavings may be purchased through the Horse Show Office. **NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS CAN BE BROUGHT ON THE GROUNDS.**
4. **CANCELLATIONS:** **Stall rent and entry fees will not be refunded.**
5. **SEE ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS**
6. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** Photographs of Champion and Reserve Champion horses will be taken by the official photographer of the Tri-State Fair & Rodeo.
7. **HUMANE TREATMENT** of animals must be exercised at all times by exhibitors and their employees. Violations will result in disqualification. No horses may be tied to trailers.
8. **ELIGIBILITY:** **All AQHA Shows entries will refer to the 2020 AQHA Rule Book. All AQHA rules apply.**
9. **FAXED ENTRIES:** All faxed entries must be received with **entry form, copy of registration papers, AQHA member card and must be paid with credit card or late fee will apply.**
10. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions of a new horse for a horse entered under the same ownership will be allowed within the same breed at no additional charge. All substitutions must be made no later than noon the day preceding judging.
11. **LOAD IN/LOAD OUT:** Exhibitors will load in and out from the South side of the Bill Cody Arena, and then park their vehicles and trailers in designated areas. Load in and out periods will be restricted to 15 minutes. Vehicles may be towed after this time.

**FEE SCHEDULE**

**STALL AND ENTRY FEES:**

- A. STALL FEE: \$20/HORSE/NIGHT
- B. TACK STALL: \$25/SHOW
- C. Entry Fee: (see with respective shows) **Entry fees must be submitted with respective application forms.**
- D. **Exhibitors are issued a parking pass upon arrival at Gate 3.**  
**Additional Parking Permits can be purchased in the Fair office for \$10. Free parking at Gates 1 & 5**
- E. **Must have Current Coggins (12 months) Paper to show at Gate 3. No papers you will be asked to turn around and leave.**
