Late entries accepted until 5 p.m. the first business day of September 2020 with a late charge of \$60, plus the \$30 entry fee.

SPECIAL RULES

1. **Entries:** Made in this division shall be subject to the General Rules and Livestock Department Rules published in this premium list.
2. ~~**You must have a Parking Permit on your windshield to enter Gates 2 or 3. Parking Permits can be purchased in the Fair office for \$10. Free parking at Gates 1 & 5.**~~
3. **Breeds:** Barrows only will be shown by weight in six breed classes: 1) Duroc, 2) Hampshire, 3) Black OPB, 4) White OPB, 5) Crosses and 6) Yorkshire.
4. **Eligibility:** Any regularly enrolled 4-H or FFA members in Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service District 1, 2 and 3.
5. **Certification:** Each entry must be certified by the supervising AgriLife Extension Agent or FFA Agriculture Science Teacher.
6. **Ethics:** See Livestock Department Rules.
7. **Gilts:** No gilts will be allowed in the barn.
8. **Dressing & Coloring:** Powdering, oiling, painting and dressing other than water will not be allowed. No change of the natural color pattern of the animal by painting or dyeing will be allowed. Any grooming material that allows color to come off from any animal will not be allowed at the show.
9. **Residue Avoidance Program:** (Certification form required)
10. **Number of Entries:** No limit. *See Livestock Rules
11. **Ownership:** Exhibitors must have owned, had possession of and cared for their animal from July 1, 2020 until time of show.
12. **Fitting/Showing:** See Livestock Department Rules.

13. **Weights/Classification:** All weights will be turned in by 9 P.M. Saturday, Sept. 19, 2020. Barrows will be placed in classes according to breed and weight. The top two animals that place in each class will be weighed immediately after judging and will be disqualified if they weigh more than 10 lbs. over their turned-in weight. All champions and reserve barrows will be weighed prior to the selection of the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion. Champions and Reserve Champions must maintain this 10 lb. tolerance or will not be considered for Grand and Reserve Champions. Classification will be done prior to each class and any barrow classed out will be moved to the appropriate crossbred class. Classification will be based on physical characteristics. Judgment of the classifier is final and is not subject to protest.
14. **Weight Limits:** There will be no weight limits.
15. **Class Size:** The number of classes and the size of each class will be determined by the superintendents and the Fair management after animals are in place at the show. Total premiums paid for all classes may not exceed total premiums offered in this department.
16. **Bedding:** Wood shavings will be provided as first bedding. Additional shavings may be purchased at the Bill Cody Arena Office for \$11 per bag

Premiums will be paid on the following basis for 50% of the animal in each breed class, not to exceed 10 places in any class.
