ENTRY FEE.....\$2.50 PER BIRD
Late entries will be accepted until Sept. 1, 2019 at a \$2 additional fee per bird.
No entries accepted after Sept. 1, 2019.
Please state on entry card Open or Junior. Also please specify Large Fowl or Bantam.

SPECIAL RULES:

1. **Eligibility:** The show is open to the world. Youth may enter both shows provide separate fees and entry forms are submitted. Youth must be ages 4-18 as of Sept. 1, 2019. Separate birds must be shown in each division.
2. **Judging:** Judging will be by comparison with only licensed American Bantam Association or American Poultry Association judges used.
3. **Late Entries:** Entries postmarked after Aug. 26, 2019 will be considered late. Late entries will be accepted until Sept. 1, 2019 at a \$2 additional fee per bird. No entries accepted after Sept. 1, 2019.
4. **Fair Passes:** One pass will be issued to exhibitors with 5 or more birds entered.
5. **You must have a Parking Permit on your windshield to enter Gates 2 or 3. Parking Permits can be purchased in the Fair office for \$10. FREE parking at Gates 1 & 5.**
6. Only healthy birds will be accepted by the show for exhibition.
7. Exhibitors not delivering their birds should ship them with all charges prepaid to Amarillo Bantam Club, Tri-State Fair & Rodeo, 3301 SE 10th Ave, Amarillo, Texas 79104. They must arrive during the time of entry.
8. Substitutes will be permitted when they are the same breed, sex class and variety.
9. All birds entered in competition and sold will remain until release date.
10. No exhibitor or spectator will be permitted in the aisles where judging is in progress or in any manner interfere with the judges or attempt to influence his decision.
11. **Mark entries: Open, Youth or Standard.**
12. Only paid exhibitors entered in the Bantam show may bring birds for sale into the show barn and may coop only Bantam, Chickens, Ducks and standard chickens.

13. The Show Superintendent and Management shall have full authority to make any decision necessary in order to conduct this show in an orderly and efficient manner.
14. **The Texas Pullorum Disease and Fowl Control Act of 1977 requires all poultry going on public exhibition to originate from pullorum-typhoid clean flocks or hatcheries or to have a negative pullorum-typhoid test within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition. Entries may satisfy these requirements by any of the following methods: (1) Originate from a flock of certified "U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Clean" by the National Poultry Improvement Plan. (2) Originate from a flock certified "Pullorum-Typhoid Clean" by the Texas Pullorum Disease and Fowl Typhoid Control Program. (3) A negative reaction to a Pullorum-Typhoid test conducted by an authorized testing agent within 90 days prior to the show. Entries satisfying the requirements by methods 1, 2, or 3 must be accompanied by a NPIP Form or a Texas Pullorum-Typhoid Control Program Report or a certificate issued by an authorized Agent verifying a date of test. No testing agent will be at the show. Exhibitor must call and make an appointment to have birds tested before the show to Monty Fitzgerald at (940) 736-4204.**
15. This show will host the following club meets: A.B.A., Old English Game Bantam Club of America, A.P.A., Silkie State Meet and others.
16. The Tri-State Fair & Rodeo will no longer furnish feed and water containers.
