 Recipes and entries will admit contestant (only) to fairgrounds through Gate 2 from 4:30-6 p.m. A youth contestant with entry and recipe may be accompanied by 1 adult and enter through Gate 2.

**COMPETITION RULES, NON-PROFESSIONAL**

1. The 2019 Abuelo’s Homemade Salsa Contest will consist of two categories: Tomato and Non-Tomato Based Salsas (Tomatillo salsa will be judged in the tomato category).
2. Contestants may enter both Tomato and Non-Tomato Salsa categories. Only 1 entry per person per category.
3. Recipe and homemade salsa will admit contestant (only) to fairgrounds (Gate 2) between 5-6 p.m.
4. Salsa must be exhibited in a pint size canning jar. Salsa brought in any other container will be disqualified.
5. Entries must consist of a homemade salsa prepared within the last 3 days and must be refrigerated throughout that time period.
6. Entry will consist of salsa and recipe only. Display space limited to 12”. Decorations not permitted.
7. Recipes must be typed or neatly printed and submitted with the salsa on an 8 ½” x 11” sheet of paper. Exhibitor’s name, address and phone number to be printed in lower right corner of page.
8. All recipes become the property of Abuelo’s and Tri-State Fair & Rodeo.
9. First place winners from the 2018 Homemade Salsa Contest are not eligible to compete in the 2019 competition in the category they won the prior year.
10. The decision of the judges will be final.
