## SPECIAL RULES

- 1. Read General Rules:** All exhibitors will be required to follow the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and the Health and Sanitary Regulations outlined in the front of this of book as well as the Junior Division General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Nominations:** Doe Goats showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2020. For junior nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.
- 3. Pens:** Pens will be pre assigned prior to arrival.
- 4. Retag:** There will be a \$5 retag fee at the time of Check In if you have not retagged before the show.
- 5. Ownership:** Exhibitor must have owned, cared for and fed does daily before July 1.
- 6. Scrapie Tag or Tattoo:** A scrapie tag or tattoo will be required on all breeding does at the time of the show.
- 7. Teeth:** All doe kids may have lost their milk teeth at the time of the show; however, the two permanent incisors must not have broken the gum line.
- 8. Weight:** Minimum weight requirement for breeding does is 40 pounds. There is no official weigh-in of breeding does.
- 9. Weigh Back:** Upon the completion of each class, the Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top 5 does. Any doe which has gained more than 5 pounds from the weight on the weigh card will be disqualified.
- 10. Class Breaks:** Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head in each class.
- 11. Show Limit:** Exhibitors may show a maximum of 3 Breeding Does.
- 12. Bracing:** Bracing of animals will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal by the judge or superintendent. The animals must have all four feet on the ground. Animals must be shown with a collar used only to control the animal. Exhibitor can only briefly touch the animal with his body. Exhibitor cannot use the collar to make the animal tense his muscles. Any violation will result in dismissal.
- 13. Shearing:** Length of hair is left up to the discretion of the exhibitor.
- 14. Horns:** Dehorning of goats in this show is not suggested; however horns should be tipped and rounded. Goats with horns sharper than deemed safe by Superintendent or Fair staff will be required to be tipped and rounded or isolated and not shown.
- 15. Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$45, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$40, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$35, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$30, 6<sup>th</sup> - \$25, 7<sup>th</sup> - \$20, 8<sup>th</sup> - \$15, 9<sup>th</sup> - \$10, 10<sup>th</sup> - \$10
