## SPECIAL RULES

### PROSPECT STEERS & HEIFERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION

- Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring code of Ethics and Animal Health Regulations, and the Junior General Rules and Regulations.
- Ownership:** Exhibitors must be the sole owner of any animals shown by August 30, 2019.
- Show Limit:** No maximum on number of animals an exhibitor may show; however, no steer or heifer will be allowed to show in two different breeds.
- Stalling:** Stalls will be assigned by county and only for competing livestock.
- Bedding Removal:** Bedding is provided in the cattle stalls. Removal of the bedding for tack or feed is prohibited. Tack and feed must be stored in the tack aisle.
- Weigh In:** Scales will be available for weighing of animals between 1 pm - 4 pm Monday, October 5, in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Arena. Exhibitors will be responsible for declaring his/her animal's weight in at the Kiosk or by phone check in on Monday, October 5 by 5 pm. Kiosks will be available from 3 pm – 5 pm. Maximum weight will be 1000 pounds.
- Weigh Back:** There will be a weigh back in class of the top three steers and heifers with a 5% variance allowed.
- Ready Ring:** Prospect steers and heifers will proceed from the ready ring to the final holding area before their class. **ONLY** exhibitors and their animals will allowed in the final holding area.
- Class Breaks:** Classes will be posted in the livestock office. Exhibitors must weigh their animals and turn weights in by 5 pm Monday, October 5.
- Hair:** No alteration or simulation with respect to color or hair will be permitted on any animals (This includes all products, natural or man-made, false switch permitted.) If alteration or addition is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year.
- Grooming Chutes:** Due to limited space, the use of grooming chutes is discouraged. Grooming chute passes may be purchased for \$50.
- Tie-Outs:** Tie-Outs are \$10 per head and will be assigned prior to arrival. Spots are limited and will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Tie-out time will be 7 pm each day, except those breeds who show the following day will be allowed to tie-out at 6 pm.
- Breeds:** Breeds eligible and recognized Angus, Charolais, Chianina, Hereford, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Shorthorn, Simmental, and Crossbred. Any other breeds not listed will show in the AOB division.
- Prospect Market Heifers:** All market heifers will be shown together regardless of breed. The classes within this division will be broken by weight and will generate one Division Champion, Reserve Champion, 3<sup>rd</sup> Best eligible for the Overall Champion Drive in the Prospect Show.
- Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$40.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$35.00, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$30.00, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$25.00
