Entry Deadline: Submit online entry by September 4, 2020. Entry fee – \$5 per division entered.

Late Entry: September 12, 2020. Late Entry Fee: \$10 per division entered.

Extra Late Entry: Exhibitors may enter at the show for a \$15 fee per division entered. All show day entries must be submitted at the Livestock Office or as noted in each section below.

SPECIAL RULES

1. **Eligibility:** Only exhibitors with animals entered and showing in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Division are eligible.
2. **Animal:** Exhibitors must use their own animal that is properly entered in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Division when entering the showmanship contest.
3. **Dress Code:** All exhibitors are required to abide by the official dress code for the Tulsa State Fair Junior Shows.
4. **Fitting:** No fitting allowed in the Heifer Showmanship Contest. Steers may be fitted, but it is not a requirement.
5. **Age and Show Order:** Contestants will be divided and shown in the following order (age as of day of show):
 - a. Junior: 8 and in the 3rd grade - 11 years old
 - b. Intermediate: 12-14 years old
 - c. Senior: 15-19 years old
6. **Premiums:** 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$45, 3rd - \$40, 4th - \$35, 5th - \$30
Rosettes will be presented to the Champion and Reserve Champion Showman in each age group. Buckle and Banner will be presented to the Overall Champion and Reserve Overall Champion in each division.
7. **Richard Gebhart Scholarship Award:** The Overall Champion in each division will receive a tuition waiver to Rogers State University. Scholarship award must be redeemed by attending Rogers State University. Not a cash exchange.
8. **Showmanship Divisions:**
 - a. **Gilt Showmanship:** Friday, October 2, 4 pm in the Explorer Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Youth Gilt Show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 2 pm on Friday, October 2. A Pre-Junior Showmanship Contest will be offered during the Gilt Showmanship only. Age will be 5 years – 8 years and in the 2nd grade and youth exhibitor must be entered in the Gilt Show to eligible to participate. No premiums will be paid out in the Pre-Junior Showmanship, just awards.
 - b. **Steer Showmanship:** Tuesday, October 6, 5 pm in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Prospect Steer and Heifer Show and Market Steer Shows are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 11 am on Tuesday, October 6.
 - c. **Breeding Heifer Showmanship:** Friday, October 9, 2 pm in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Breeding Heifer shows are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 10 am on Friday, October 9, in the livestock office.
 - d. **Market Barrow Showmanship:** Monday, October 5, 4 pm in the Explorer Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Market Barrow show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 2 pm on Monday, October 5.
 - e. **Market Lamb Showmanship:** Monday, October 5, 6 pm in the Ranger Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Market Lamb show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries can be submitted until the start of the showmanship contest at the arena announcer's stand.
 - f. **Market Goat Showmanship:** Tuesday, October 6, 8:30 am in the Ranger Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Meat Goat Show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 7 pm on Monday, October 5.
 - g. **Breeding Doe Showmanship:** Friday, October 9, 8 am in the Super Duty Arena. Only exhibitors and animals showing in the Breeding Doe show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 7 pm on Thursday, October 8.
 - h. **Dairy Cattle Showmanship:** Saturday, October 2, 7:30 pm in the OK Ford Dealers Arena 2. Only exhibitor and animals showing the Junior Dairy Cattle Show are eligible to compete. Extra late entries must be submitted by 5pm on Saturday, October 3.
