### SPECIAL RULES

#### Horned/Polled will be shown together

1. The American Dexter Cattle Association (ADCA) pays 20% of total premium money in the Dexter classes.
2. Any additional prize money and awards will be paid/given directly from the Oklahoma Dexter Cattle Association.
3. All animals must be legibly tattooed with the exact alpha-numeric identification that appears on the registration paper.
4. All animals must be halter broke to lead and must be manageable. Unmanageable animals will be asked to leave the show ring and will not be eligible for any premium.
5. All animals must be registered with the American Dexter Cattle Association prior to entry. Calves under 6 months of age that are to be shown in cow/calf class do not need to be registered. Note: Unregistered calves are not eligible to be shown in individual classes.
6. All bulls 12 months and older must have an affixed nose ring or nose clamp.
7. Youth under the age of 7 must be accompanied by an adult in the show arena.
8. All animals must be washed and brushed. Additional grooming is left up to the discretion of the owner as long as they abide by the items that are prohibited.
9. Prohibited Grooming Items: painting or polishing of horns or hooves with colored polish; artificial coat coloring; growth implants; total body fitting – use of adhesives or wax to shape the coat to hide animal flaws.
10. Showmanship attire will be required and enforced in the show ring for any person presenting cattle.
  - a. Collared/buttoned shirts with sleeves (length of the sleeves is determined by the season/weather)
  - b. Long pants (jeans or slacks) that are dark and don't have tears or holes.
  - c. Boots or fully enclosed heavy footwear must be worn for safety reasons.
  - d. Prohibited items: baseball caps, t-shirts or crop top shirts that leave the midriff skin showing, sandals or canvas shoes (for safety reasons), overalls, baggy, low riding pants that drag on the ground (for safety reasons)
12. **Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$70, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$60, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$40, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$30, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$15
