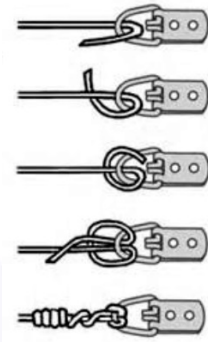
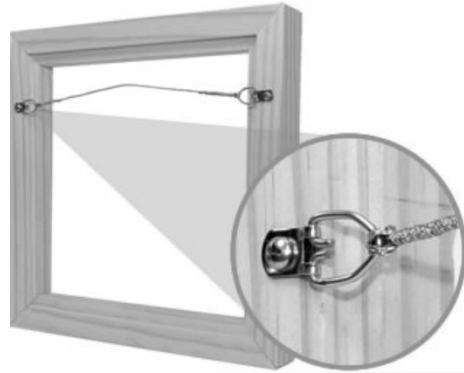
General Rules

1. Items of offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter may not be accepted.
2. Fair management holds final decision on judging and displaying of all entries if they are over a certain size.
3. Exhibits must be dry before they will be accepted by the Tulsa State Fair.
4. Only artwork and paintings must be framed for suitable hanging – no sawtooths.
5. All work must have been finished between October 2018 and September 2019.
6. ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO ONE PER CLASS. You may enter as many classes as would like.

Artwork and Paintings

1. **Cannot exceed 30" x 30", including frame**
2. Must have a hanging wire on the back of the frame. See example





Glassblowing

1. Beginner – 5 years or less experience
2. Advanced – 6 to 9 years of experience
3. Master – 10 or more years of experience

Hand-Painted Porcelain

1. No seminar pieces accepted
2. Advanced – 4 or more years of experience
3. Professional – Open to teachers & those who sell their artwork

Leather Crafting

1. Any individual having won 5 or more blue ribbons in Leather Crafting or participated for two years or more at the Tulsa State Fair, must enter in the Open Division.

Native American Arts & Crafts

1. Artifacts may not be entered

Rubber Stamping

1. Use rubber stamps, embellishments, ribbons, fibers, brads, charms, eyelets, etc.
2. No stickers
3. No peel and stick items

Scrapbooking

1. Must be 12" x 12" page in protective sleeve. The Tulsa State Fair may be pinning up pages using protected sleeves



2. All items including photos must be computer generated for digital scrapbook pages.
3. Canvas must not exceed 30" x 30", any shape is allowed
4. Shadow Boxes or Boxed Scrapbooking not to exceed 30" x 30", any shape allowed

Wood Items

1. Items must be constructed predominately of wood

Exceptional Division

1. *Exceptional entries refer to those with limited mental capacity and/or physical disability.*
