Artistic Arrangements, Cut Flowers, Fruits and Vegetables, Potted Plants, Pumpkin Decorating

Processing Fee: Non-refundable \$4 per entry
Entry Deadline: Friday, August 30, 2019
Take-In Date: Saturday, September 21, 10am – 3pm

General Rules

1. Flowers and plants will be given the best care possible, but any not suitable for display will be returned to exhibitor.
2. All horticulture, except for flower arrangements, must have been grown by the exhibitor and in his/her possession three months prior to entry. No commercial grower is eligible to enter the competition.
3. Exhibitors must conform to specified flower pot size.
4. Artificial flowers may not be used in any arrangement with the exception of silk flower arrangements.
5. Artistic arrangements must not exceed 18" around 20" in height. To be viewed on all sides.
6. Fruit and veggies should be placed on a paper plate in groups of three unless otherwise specified. (Pumpkins and eggplant are the only classes requiring just 1.)
7. Cut Flowers, Definitions:
 - Blooms – One individual flower with stem and foliage
 - Stem – main axis of plant
 - Spike – a lengthened flower cluster
 - Spray – a main stem with side branches and several blooms
8. Pumpkin Decorating:
 - Weight of pumpkin not to exceed 25 lbs.
 - After your decorations, the pumpkin should still look like a pumpkin
 - Do not carve or puncture
 - All pumpkins entered must be real
 - The Tulsa State Fair reserves the right to throw away all pumpkins that begin to decay during the Fair
