**Entry Deadline:** Entries must be submitted online by September 9, 2019. The description form must be uploaded online with entry.

### Objective:

- To show the beauty of wool garments and promote Junior Sheep activities.
- To add different dimensions to the Junior Sheep Show.
- To promote wool products.

### SPECIAL RULES

1. **Entries:** A processing fee of \$15 must be paid on all contestants entering the Lamb Lead Competition. Exhibitors must abide by entry deadline September 9. This competition will be part of the Junior Sheep Show.
2. **Participation:** Contestants must be a 4-H or FFA member. Contestant does not have to be an exhibitor in the regular sheep show in order to participate in Lamb Lead Class.
3. **Check In:** Contestants must confirm entry with the superintendent between 4 pm - 5 pm Saturday, September 28, at the Super Duty Barn Arena.
4. **Age Divisions:** There will be four age divisions. Age will be determined as of the day of competition.
  - Pre-teen division —Class 1
  - Intermediate division —Class 2
  - Junior division —Class 3
  - Senior division —Class 4
5. **Garment:** Contestant must furnish his/her own garment. Garment can be purchased or self-made
6. **Wool:** Garment must be at least 60% wool.
7. **Animal Requirements:**
  - a. Animal to be led must be a registered/unregistered ewe lamb or yearling ewe.
  - b. Animal must be trained to be halter led.
  - c. Decorations are acceptable with consideration of animal's safety and comfort given.
8. **Ownership:** Animal does not have to be owned by the contestant.
9. **Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$40, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$30, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$20, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$15, 6<sup>th</sup> - \$10
10. **Judging Standards:**
  - a. All contestants will be interviewed during the Lamb Lead Class Competition.
  - b. Mode of dress shall be attractive and lend elegance to the class competition.
  - c. Poise and appearance will be judged.
  - d. Control and presentation of the animal will be judged.
