Draft Horse Pull Rules and Regulations TWO CLASS OVER WEIGHT

Entry Deadline: August 30, 2019. Entry and payment must be submitted online at www.tulsastatefair.com.

Entry fee: \$50 per team

Arrival: All horses may begin arriving on Saturday, September 28 after 12 noon. All horses must be on the grounds by weigh-in closing time, 8 am Sunday, September 29.

Weigh In: Sunday, September 29, between 6 am and 8 am.

Light Horse Pull: Sunday, September 29, at 10 am

Heavy Horse Pull: Sunday, September 29, at 2 pm

*** Pulls will occur in this order. It's the contestant's responsibility to be on time.**

Release: Release to leave the grounds will be issued after the Draft Horse Pull Contest.

Teams must weigh 3,000 pounds and over. No Exceptions.

1. Weigh in with be from 7 am – 10 am on Sunday, September 29. Official Scales furnished by Paul's Scales.
2. Classes will be split equally between the Light and Heavy Horse Pulls. Should the pull have an odd number of entries, the extra team will pull in the Heavy Horse Pull.
3. This is a twenty (20) foot overload pull, with driver riding sled.
4. Each team has three (3) attempts to pull 20 feet. Longest distance counts.
5. All pulls must be made within a 15 foot lane.
6. No striking or whipping of the horses will be allowed.
7. All horses must comply with the Health Requirements listed in the General Horse Show Rules and Regulations and are subject to testing for use of stimulant and/or drugs. Pulling horses will be randomly blood tested based on the decision of Show Management. If a positive test is found, the team will be disqualified. If a team is disqualified, the remaining teams will be moved up in placing. Prize money and the results will be held until test results are received.
8. Use of profanity and/or intoxicating beverages will disqualify entry.
9. Drivers furnish doubletrees and helpers; helpers stay behind doubletree. Drivers will be allowed a backup on line.
10. No heading will be allowed.
11. No open bridles or changing of sides will be permitted.
12. In case of break down, sled goes back to starting point if driver desires another pull. Reasonable time will be allowed for repairs.
13. Three attempts to hook equals one pull.
14. Sled will be furnished by Tulsa State Fair.
15. Any team not under control of the driver (runaways) will be disqualified.
16. A \$10 office charge will be collected at weigh in from each team entered.
17. Premiums: 1st- \$500, 2nd- \$450, 3rd- \$400, 4th- \$350, 5th- \$300, 6th- \$250, 7th- \$200, 8th- \$150, 9th- \$100, 10th- \$100
