**Entry Deadline:** Entry and payment must be submitted online by August 30, 2019. Legal Release and Online Receipt must be mailed and postmarked by September 3. Late entries will be accepted until September 6.

**May Begin Arrival:** Thursday, October 3 at 8 pm

**Check In:** Exhibitor must check in at the Ranger Arena Office before competing in their first class of the day.

**Judging:** Friday, October 4, 9am: Ford Truck Arena and Mustang Arena

Saturday, October 5, 8am: Ford Truck Arena

Sunday, October 6, 8am: Ford Truck Arena and Ranger Arena

**Release:** Exhibitors will be released after the last class they compete in, and must be out of the barns by 7 pm

## SPECIAL RULES

- 1. Read General Rules:** Exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, General Horse Show Rules and Animal Health Regulations.
- 2. Health Requirements:** All exhibitors are responsible to follow the General Animal Health Regulations. All horses must have HEALTH PAPERS, (30 day veterinary health certificate), and COGGINS to be allowed on the Tulsa State Fairgrounds. Exhibitors arriving at the Tulsa State Fair without Health Papers and Coggins will not be allowed on the grounds.
- 3. Entry Fees:** Entry Deadline August 30, 2019.  
Horse Stall: \$30  
*\*One horse stall must be purchased per horse entered. Horse showing in the 4-H/FFA Show and Open Show are not required to purchase an additional stall for the Open Show.*  
Tack Stall (if available): \$30  
4-H & FFA Per Class Fee: \$15 non cattle classes; \$45 cattle classes
- 4. Jump Out Fee:** Horses not staying in stalls will be charged a daily jump out fee of \$20. Those horses staying overnight must purchase a stall.
- 5. Parking:** To park on grounds you must purchase a parking permit. See general rules for information and pricing.
- 6. Arrival:** Horses may begin arriving on Thursday, October 3 at 8 am. All horses must enter through Gate 7. Gate 7 is open from 6 am – 10 pm.
- 7. Exhibitor Social:** Friday, October 4, 6 pm. Enjoy, and pizza, fun activities drawing for prizes.
- 8. Class Schedule:** See Oklahoma State 4-H Horse Schedule for class listing and times.
- 9. Show Eligibility:** Exhibitors must qualify for the State 4-H Horse Show through their approved district show.
- 10. Exhibitor Eligibility:** The Tulsa State Fair Junior Livestock Shows are limited to Oklahoma 4-H members. Youth who have a 4-H enrollment card on file in their respective County Extension Office on or before July 1, have reached their 8th birthday on or before July 1, **AND** are in the 3rd grade will be eligible to show at the Tulsa State Fair. Also, 4-H members that have neither graduated from high school before May 2019 nor reached their 19th birthday before January 1, of the year of the show will be eligible to show at the Tulsa State Fair.
- 11. Ownership:** Contestant must have owned or leased the horse entered for a minimum of 120 days.
- 12. Horse Rules:** Each contestant may enter and compete on only two horses; horses must be shown by that contestant only. Contestants can only show **ONE** horse per class. No stallions may be entered. Horses shown in the 4-H show are permitted to be shown by another exhibitor in the Open Show.
- 13. Show Rules:** Oklahoma State 4-H Horse Show Rules will govern.
- 14. Stalls:** One horse stall must be purchased per horse entered. Open Show entries also showing in the State 4-H Horse Show are not required to purchase an additional stall for the same horse. All stalls are 10'x10' and are on asphalt.
- 15. Purina Honor Show Chow 4-H & FFA Horse Show Scholarship:** This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the overall Oklahoma 4-H & FFA applicant in the 15-19 age division. Scholarship recipients must adhere to the Tulsa State Fair Scholarship Guidelines and Requirements. Exhibitors can only win the scholarship once. Applicants must send in their application by August 30. Test and interview will be conducted during the Tulsa State Fair for the top applicants.
- 16. Awards:** A championship belt buckle will be awarded to the first place winner in each class. Reserve champion will also receive a special award. Ribbons will be awarded for the second through tenth place.
