NOTE: Six horse hitches who are showing at the Oklahoma State Fair, may arrive beginning September 25 with special permission from the Tulsa State Fair. Hitches must be already entered in the Tulsa State Fair Draft horse show. Please contact the Tulsa State Fair Livestock Office to arrange stalling when completing your entries.

In Place By: Friday, September 28th at 8 am

Judging: Friday, September 28 at 1 pm in the East Barn Arena and 6 pm in the Ford Truck Arena and Saturday, September 29, at 9 am and 6 pm in the Ford Truck Arena

Released: At the conclusion of the show on Saturday or by 12 pm Sunday.

SPECIAL RULES

1. **Sanctioning:** All horses are subject to the rules and regulations set up by the Oklahoma Draft Horse and Mule Association, The Tulsa State Fair and the North American Six Horse Hitch Classic Series

2. **Divisions: This year we are offering three Divisions**

- a. Draft Horses (all breeds)
- b. Horse Pony/ Draft Cross /Mule/ Driving Horses 14 Hands and Above
- c. Pony /Mule 13.3 Hands or Under

3. **Fees:**

Horse (Stall Fee): \$50

Tack Stall (if available): \$50

Class Entry Fee: \$10

Single and Team Classes: \$20

Unicorn & Four Horse Hitch Class Fee: \$25

Six Horse Hitch Class Fee: \$50

4. **Registration Papers:** A copy of registration papers must be sent on all registered horses. If no papers are sent and horse is entered in halter class, it will be entered in the gelding class. First place mares, stallions and geldings of all breeds to combine for Grand/Reserve Mare, Stallion and Gelding.

5. **Arrivals:** All vehicles hauling livestock must use Gate 7 on 15th Street. Health papers will be checked before unloading. Gate 7 is open from 6 am - 10 pm no livestock will be allowed to enter the grounds while gate 7 is closed.

6. **Stalling:** All horses must stall and pay a stall fee per each horse.

7. **Call for Classes:** Contestants will receive 3 calls per class. After the 3rd call, the gates will close. No exceptions.

8. **Animal & Equipment Condition:** All animals, wagons and harness should be in clean and good condition.

9. **Exhibitor Conduct:** All exhibitors and assistants should be dressed appropriately. Each exhibitor must wear the correct number for that class. The number may be attached to person or cart or wagon.

10. **Show Ring Conduct:** No person shall be permitted in the ring during the time of judging of classes except the judge, ring steward, exhibitor and one groom or header for each driving class as needed.

11. **Hitch Classes:** The hitch classes are considered group classes. More than one owner may participate in a hitch class but only one owner should make the entry and pay the entry fee for the team. Only one driver is permitted in any of the classes. One rider is optional.

12. **Logging, Gamblers Choice, Scurry, and Driving Obstacle Classes:**

a. May use farm harness or scotch collars.

b. No manes or tails braided.

c. Exhibitor must furnish fore cart or two-wheel cart for the gamblers choice single or team obstacle.

13. **Hitch Class:**

a. An adult must ride with any junior driver.

b. Show hitches must have a fifth wheel wagon.

14. **Six Horse Hitch Class: 2018 will be a double point show for the North American Six horse Hitch Classic Series. hitches will show both Friday and Saturday Evenings.** A minimum of \$2,500 will be paid for each six Horse Hitch class. Six horse hitch entrants must be members of the North American Six Horse Hitch Association. In addition, the Oklahoma Draft Horse & Mule Association is assisting in Sponsoring all six horse hitches:

15. **Course:** Obstacle course layouts will be given out at exhibitor meeting. A walkthrough will be held before each obstacle event.

16. **Costume Classes:** Theme to be Disney Characters: A 2 or 4-wheel vehicle may be driven. (Does not have to be antique vehicle.) A horse may be ridden or walked. Farm or show harness may be used. All costumes should be theme related.

17. **Pleasure Driving Classes:** Does not require show harness, shoes, or braids.

18. **Draft Cross Horses:** Draft crosses over 16 hands will be shown with Draft horses. Draft Crosses under 16 hands will show in the Draft pony/Mule classes.

19. **Exhibitor Meeting:** Draft Horse Show participants are encouraged to attend a meeting at the ODHMA Hospitality Booth Friday, September 29 at 9 am.

20. **Junior Drivers:** Junior drivers must be between the ages of 8 and 17.

21. **Oklahoma Born and Bred:** Open to all draft breeds, all sexes and all ages

22. **Farm Team and Youth Farm Team:** Is open to any draft horse or mules 14 hands and taller. Any wagon or forecart may be used.
