Entry Deadline: Entry and payment must be submitted online by August 30, 2019, 12 midnight. Legal Release Form and Online Receipt must be postmarked mailed by September 3, 2019.

SPECIAL RULES

1. **Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, and Health and Sanitary Regulations in the front of this book as well as the General Rules governing the Junior Division.
2. **Show Limit:** Each exhibitor may only show a total of two purebreds per class and a total of three commercials. Any one animal may not show in two different breeds.
6. **Purebred Ewe Registration Papers:** All entries must be registered and recorded by a recognized breed association in the name of the exhibitor. Ewes owned jointly are not eligible to show. No pending papers will be accepted at the time of entry. Registration papers must be checked prior to showing. **Ownership:** Registration papers must show the ewes were owned by the exhibitor prior to July 1 of the current year. The ewes must have been owned, cared for daily and fed by exhibitor prior to July 1.
7. **Commercial Ewe Nominations:** Commercial Ewe Lambs showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2019. For junior animal nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.
8. **Commercial Ewe Weigh Cards:** All weigh cards must be turned in by Saturday, September 28, 3:00 p.m.
9. **Commercial Ewe Retag:** There will be a \$5 retag fee if you have not retagged prior to arrival. Retags at the show will be at 1 pm Saturday.
10. **Commercial Ewe Weight:** The minimum weight is 90 pounds. There is no maximum weight.
11. **Weigh Back:** Upon completion of each class, the Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top five (5) commercial ewes. Any ewe which has gained more than 5 pounds from the weight listed on the official weight card will be disqualified.
12. **Fungus Inspection:** All sheep will be checked for fungus. Blankets must be removed. Any sheep with fungus confirmed will be asked to leave the grounds.
13. **Teeth:** Ewe lambs must have lambs teeth with no visible signs of permanent teeth.
14. **Tags:** Flock tags, tattoos, and/or registry association tags must be in the ear of the ewe NO EXCEPTIONS.
15. **Grooming:** Artificial coloring, paint, or powder will not be permitted for use on ewes during the entire show. If such is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor, organized group or individual involved will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year.
16. **Shearing:** All lambs must be slick shorn to the skin. Shropshire sheep will be allowed to shear according to the American Shropshire Registry breed standards. Shearing will be allowed on the fairgrounds for Breeding Sheep ONLY.
17. **Purebred Ewe Bred & Owned:**
 - a. To be eligible for the B&O class, the breeder and the owner of the animal must be one and the same. Registration papers will serve as proof for entering the class.
 - b. Ewes eligible for the B&O class must show in their respective age class prior to competing for the B&O awards.
 - c. The highest place B&O ewes in their respective age class will return to be placed in the B&O class.
 - d. All Junior Breeding Ewe exhibitors who are going to show in the B&O class must indicate their intentions upon entry.
