## SPECIAL RULES

### PROSPECT STEERS & HEIFERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION

- Sponsor:** The Prospect Steer & Heifer Show is sponsored by the Oklahoma Club Calf Association. All rules of the OCCA and Tulsa State Fair apply. All breeds recognized by the OCCA will be eligible to show.
- Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring code of Ethics and Animal Health Regulations, and the Junior General Rules and Regulations.
- Ownership:** Exhibitors must be the sole owner of any animals shown by August 30, 2019.
- Show Limit:** No maximum on number of animals an exhibitor may show; however, no steer or heifer will be allowed to show in two different breeds.
- Stalling:** Stalls will be assigned by county and only for competing livestock.
- Bedding Removal:** Bedding is provided in the cattle stalls. Removal of the bedding for tack or feed is prohibited. Tack and feed must be stored in the tack aisle.
- Weigh In:** Scales will be available for weighing of animals between 1 pm - 4 pm Monday, September 30, in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Arena. Exhibitors will be responsible for declaring his/her animal's weight in at the Cattle Kiosk on Monday, September 30 by 5 pm. Kiosks will be available from 3 pm – 5 pm. Maximum weight will be 1000 pounds.
- Weigh Back:** There will be a weigh back in class of the top three steers and heifers with a 5% variance allowed.
- Ready Ring:** Prospect steers and heifers will proceed from the ready ring to the final holding area before their class. **ONLY** exhibitors and their animals will allowed in the final holding area.
- Class Breaks:** Classes will be established after all animals are weighed. Classes will be posted in the livestock office. Exhibitors must weigh their animals and turn weight cards in by 5 pm Monday, September 30. Classes will be posted on Tuesday, October 1.
- Hair:** No alteration or simulation with respect to color or hair will be permitted on any animals (This includes all products, natural or man-made, false switch permitted.) If alteration or addition is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year.
- Grooming Chutes:** Due to limited space, the use of grooming chutes is discouraged. Only one grooming chute pass per every 5 head per FFA Chapter/4-H County will be sold. Grooming chute passes may be purchased for \$50.
- Tie-Outs:** Tie-Outs are \$10 per head and will be assigned prior to arrival. Spots are limited and will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Tie-out time will be 7 pm each day, except those breeds who show the following day will be allowed to tie-out at 6 pm.
- Breeds:** All breeds sanctioned with the OCCA will be eligible to show in the Tulsa State Fair Prospect Steer & Heifer Show. (See [www.oklahomaclubcalfassociation.com](http://www.oklahomaclubcalfassociation.com) for current breed list).
- Prospect Market Heifers:** All market heifers will be shown together regardless of breed. The classes within this division will be broken by weight and will generate one Division Champion, Reserve Champion, 3<sup>rd</sup> Best, 4<sup>th</sup> Best, and 5<sup>th</sup> Best eligible for the Overall Champion Drive in the Prospect Show.
- Premiums:** All entry fees will be paid back in class premiums.
