May Begin Arrival: Monday, September 30, 8 am

In Place By: Monday, September 30, 6 pm

Weights Due: Weights 74 and under by 7 pm on Monday, September 30 at the Goat Kiosk
Weights 75 and over by 2 pm on Tuesday, October 1 at the Goat Kiosk

Showmanship: Tuesday, October 1, 8:30 am in the Super Duty Arena

Judging: Tuesday, October 1, 1 pm in the Ranger Arena. Show weights 74 and under.

Wednesday, October 2, 9 am in the Ranger Arena. Show weights 75 and over.

Released: At the conclusion of each show day, with the exception of the Junior Livestock Auction participants. Must be out of pens by 8 pm on Wednesday, October 2.

Entry Deadline: Entry and payment must be submitted online by September 1, 2019, 12 midnight. Legal Release Form and Online Receipt must be postmarked mailed by September 3, 2019. Nomination does not constitute entry.

Processing Fee: \$15

SPECIAL RULES

- 1. Read General Rules:** All exhibitors will be required to follow the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and the Animal Health Regulations outlined in the front of this book as well as the Junior General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Unauthorized Animals:** Goats not entered in the Junior Meat Goat Show will not be allowed on the grounds.
- 3. Ownership:** Exhibitor must have owned, cared for and fed daily wethers before July 1.
- 4. Nominations:** Wether Goats showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2019. For junior market animal nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.
- 5. Retag:** There will be a \$5 retag fee at the time of Check In if you have not retagged before the show.
- 6. Stalling:** Pens will be assigned by the designated superintendent by County. No pens will be built outside of the Barn. Due to space availability, there will be no tack stalls.
- 7. Clipping:** Wethers must be clipped to a maximum of 3/8" remaining hair length. All clipping must be done before arrival. There will be no clipping of wethers after arrival at the Fair. This must be done prior to coming on the Fairgrounds. Cordless clippers will be permitted for grooming purposes only. **All body body clipping must be done before arrival.**
- 8. Tables:** Due to space limitations, NO blocking tables will be allowed on the grounds. Stands found on the grounds will be locked up by management. Showrails or headpieces are permitted.
- 9. Weight:** Wether goats must weigh a minimum of 45 lbs.
- 10. Weigh Back:** The Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top 5 wethers. Any wether which has gained more than 5lbs. from the weight on the weigh card will be disqualified.
- 11. Class Breaks:** Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head in each class.
- 12. Show Limit:** Exhibitors may show a maximum of 3 Wethers.
- 13. Bracing:** Wether Goats will be allowed to brace.
- 14. Horns:** Horns should be tipped and rounded.
- 15. Selection of Junior Livestock Auction:** The number of goats that qualify for the sale will be based on the total number of goats entered in the show. 25 goats will be selected for the sale. The sale order for wether meat goats will be Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, and Division Champions, as placed by the judge. Remaining sale order will be selected by the judge. The number of wethers selected by the judge in each division for the premium sale will be on a percentage basis of the total number shown.
Only the Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Division Champions, and Reserve Division Champions are required to sell. All other sale qualifying meat goats can be removed from the sale within 30 minutes after the final sale order is posted. The exhibitor must sign the official Sale Removal Form to remove a goat from the sale.
- 16. Junior Livestock Auction Meeting:** There will be a gathering for all Junior Auction participants immediately following the meat goat show at the Super Duty Arena. It is a requirement that each Junior Auction participant be present. Any and all instructions concerning the Junior Auction will be given at this time.

17. **Livestock Judging Contest Notice:** Please be aware when your animal is selected to participate in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Livestock Auction, it has been committed to be used in the 4-H and FFA Livestock Judging Contest. A contest official will notify you if your animal will be used.
