### DIVISION RULES

1. **Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, and Animal Health Regulations.
2.  **Exhibitor Eligibility:** Open to Oklahoma 4-H and FFA Members or ADGA Youth Members.
3. **Breeds Offered:** Alpine, La Mancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhaslis, Recorded Grades, Sable, Saanen, Toggenburg
4. **Registration Papers:** The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA Office is required for all animals under six months of age and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of this show. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped application, faxes or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate. **The animal must be owned by the exhibitor.**
5. **Age:** The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is to be judged.
6. **Milkout:** There will be NO pre-show milkout.
7. **Pens:** Pens will be assigned. No tents or tent like structures will be permitted in the Dairy Goat pen area. Back drops and side curtains will be permitted on tack pens. However, these must be no higher than regular pen height.
8. **Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo. Any goat said to be without a tattoo by the judge of the show will forfeit the premium money given by the Tulsa State Fair.
