## DIVISION RULES

- Read Rules and Regulations:** All Junior Dairy Cattle exhibitors are subject to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, and Animal Health Rules.
- Animal Registration:** All animals entered for exhibition must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor in the respective herd books, and transfers duly recorded and full and satisfactory Certificates of Registry must be produced at check in.
- Ownership:** Certificate of registration will determine ownership. Animals owned in partnership may be shown, except at time of entry, a determination of who shows the animal must be made. The name of the exhibitor must be on the certificate of registration.
- Animal Eligibility:** Animals at the following levels of a genetic recovery program are ineligible to compete at the Tulsa State Fair: Ayrshire: 87%, Brown Swiss: ID (369 prefix), Guernsey: OA and PR, Holstein: 87%, Jersey: JI, OA and PR, Milking Shorthorn: 3600 and 3700
- NEW Bedding:** Bedding will NOT be provided. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their bedding.
- Dress:** Dairy exhibitors may choose to show in white. An emblem of at least 2 1/2" of the organization they represent must be worn on their show attire.
- Barn Etiquette/Camping:** Personal items (bed rolls, air mattresses, and other camping necessities) will only be allowed in the stall area from 10pm to 7am. All camping items must be put away by 7am to keep our barns neat and clean for the public to view.
- Class Breaks:** The following classes apply to all junior dairy breeds. The base date for computing ages for all breeds of Dairy Cattle are September 1 & March 1.
