## DIVISION RULES

- 1. Read General Rules:** All exhibitors and participants are required to read and comply with the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, Animal Health Regulations, and the Division Rules.
- 2. Unauthorized Animals:** Goats not entered in the Junior Meat Goat Show will not be allowed on the grounds.
- 3. Ownership:** Exhibitor must have owned, cared for and fed daily wethers before July 1.
- 4. Nominations:** Wether Goats showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2021. For junior market animal nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.
- 5. Ear Tags:** All meat goats will be issued an ear tag at nomination time and must have the ear tag properly in the ear when entering the show ring.
- 6. Stalling:** Pens will be assigned by the designated superintendent by County. No pens will be built outside of the Barn. Due to space availability, there will be no tack stalls.
- 7. Clipping:** Wethers must be clipped to a maximum of 3/8" remaining hair length. All clipping must be done before arrival. There will be no clipping of wethers after arrival at the Fair. This must be done prior to coming on the Fairgrounds. Cordless clippers will be permitted for grooming purposes only. **All body body clipping must be done before arrival.**
- 8. Grooming:** Animals are to be shown in natural conformation and color. No false hair or alteration to animal which includes attachment of hair substances such as twin, fiber, fake hair, etc. No artificial coloring, paint, or powder.
- 9. Grooming Stands:** Grooming stand permits may be purchased for \$10 at the time of entry or in the Livestock Office. For safety purposes, grooming stands will not be allowed in any walking area or aisles. All grooming stands will be issued an official identification tag, which must be displayed on the grooming stand. Space will not be guaranteed for grooming stands.
- 10. Weight:** Wether goats must weigh a minimum of 45 lbs.
- 11. Weigh Back:** The Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top 5 wethers. Any wether which has gained more than 5lbs. from the weight on the weigh card will be disqualified.
- 12. Class Breaks:** Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head in each class.
- 13. Show Limit:** Exhibitors may show a maximum of 3 Wethers.
- 14. Bracing:** Wether Goats will be allowed to brace.
- 15. Horns:** Horns should be tipped and rounded.
- 16. Selection of Night of Champions Premium Sale:** The number of goats that qualify will be based on the total number of goats entered in the show. The order for wether meat goats will be Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Division Champions, Reserve Division Champions, as placed by the judge. Remaining order will be selected by the judge. The number of wethers selected by the judge in each division for the premium sale will be on a percentage basis of the total number shown.
- 17. Awards:**
