## **DIVISION RULES**

## PROSPECT STEERS & HEIFERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE NIGHT OF CHAMPIONS AND PREMIUM SALE

- 1. **Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring code of Ethics and Animal Health Regulations.
- 2. **Ownership:** Exhibitors must be the sole owner of any animals shown by August 28, 2020.
- 3. **Show Limit:** No maximum on number of animals an exhibitor may show; however, no steer or heifer will be allowed to show in two different breeds.
- 4. **Stalling:** Stalls will be assigned by county. No stalls will be used for any purpose other than to stall competing livestock.
- 5. **Bedding:** Bedding will NOT be provided in the cattle stalls. Exhibitors are responsible for providing the bedding.
- 6. Weigh In: Scales will be available for weighing of animals between 1 pm 4 pm Monday, October 5, in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Arena. Exhibitors will be responsible for declaring the animal's weight at the Kiosk or by phone check in on Monday, October 5 by 5 pm. Kiosks will be available from 3 pm 5 pm. Maximum weight will be 1000 pounds.
- 7. Weigh Back: There will be a weigh back in class of the top three steers and heifers with a 5% variance allowed.
- 8. Class Breaks: Classes will be posted at the Livestock Office and online.
- 9. **Grooming Chutes:** Due to limited space, the use of grooming chutes is discouraged. Grooming chute passes may be purchased for \$50 at the time of entry or in the Livestock Office. For safety purposes, grooming chutes will ONLY be permitted in the stall area assigned or designated grooming areas. Grooming chutes will not be allowed in any walking area, aisles or outside of the Barns. Additional stall space is not allocated for chutes. All grooming chutes will be issued an official identification tag, which must be displayed on the upper right corner of the grooming chute.
- 10. Equipment: Tack and feed must be stored in the tack aisle. No generators, port-a-cools, or aisle fans will be allowed.
- 11. **Tie-Outs:** Tie-Outs are \$10 per head and will be assigned prior to arrival. Spots are limited and will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Tie-out time will be 7 pm each day, except those breeds who show the following day will be allowed to tie-out at 6 pm.
- 12. Holding Area: No persons, except for the exhibitor and one helper, (parent, sibling, FFA Instructor, 4-H Representative, or fellow 4-H/FFA Exhibitor), will be allowed in the holding area. This will be strictly enforced.
- 13. **Show Ring:** All persons, except those exhibiting animals, will be excluded from the judging ring while judging is in progress. Steers must be under the control of the exhibitor at all times while in the judging arena. The ring stewards may render minimal assistance to exhibitors while in the judging arena; however, the show management reserves the right to disqualify any steer deemed uncontrollable or any steer, which requires more than one person to control it.
- 14. **Breeds:** Breeds eligible and recognized: Angus, Charolais, Chianina, Hereford, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Shorthorn, Simmental, and Crossbred. Any other breeds not listed will show in the AOB division.
- 15. **Prospect Market Heifers:** All market heifers will be shown together regardless of breed. The classes within this division will be broken by weight and will generate one Division Champion, Reserve Champion, 3<sup>rd</sup> Best eligible for the Overall Champion Drive in the Prospect Show.
