SPECIAL RULES

**The Tulsa State Fair ring and the Green Country ring will run simultaneously during the junior and senior show of the Tulsa State Fair. Additional handlers may be available but we encourage exhibitors to plan accordingly. **

1. **Sanctioning:** This is an officially sanctioned ADGA Show - ADGA rules and Tulsa State Fair rules will govern. The Junior Show and Junior/Senior Combined shows are separately sanctioned. The order of the show is subject to change to keep the show progressing in a timely manner.

2. **Registration Papers:** The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and this MUST be shown at check in Tuesday, September 24 5pm-8pm. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA Office is required for all animals under six months of age and this MUST be shown at check in on Tuesday September 24, 5pm-8pm. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped application, faxes or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.

3. **Age:** The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is to be judged.

4. **Exhibitors are asked to dress appropriately in white as outline in the ADGA Guidebook.**

5. **Milkout:** There will be NO pre-show milkout.

6. **Pens:** Pens will be assigned As per TSF rules.

7. **Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo. Any goat said to be without a tattoo by the judge of the show will forfeit any legs awarded as per ADGA rules.

SPECIALS Champion Challenge: The following rules must apply:

A. Permanent champions may show in either the regular or Challenge class, whichever the owner chooses.

B. Grand Champion of the same show must show in this class and winner of them shall be called "Best of Breed".

C. If the Grand Champion of the day does not win this class, she shall not compete in the Best Doe in Show Class - the winner of the Challenge class shall.
