LITTLE MISS & MR FIRECRACKER RULES & INFO

Date and Time: Thursday, July 4, 2019. Check-In begins at 9am. Pageant will begin PROMPTLY at 10:30am. Please be on time. Check-in table will be located inside the Event Center Foyer.

Registration Deadline: Register by 5pm Tuesday, July 2 and pay \$10 entry. No entries will be accepted on day of event.

Pageant Location: Uvalde County Fairplex Event Center

Two Age Divisions: Walking through 2yrs & 3 through 5 years of age

Competition will consist of Beach/Swim wear (your choice) and a Fourth of July Themed Outfit. Attire is at the discretion of the contestant, but should be age appropriate and in good taste at all times. Outfits should be something that the contestant feels comfortable and confident in ☺.

Modeling Pattern: Contestants will have two opportunities to walk the stage for Judges; once in Beach/Swim Wear and once in a Fourth of July Themed Outfit. In each case, Contestants will enter from left side of stage to pose, front of stage to pose and then right side to pose and exit off the stage. The stage will be marked. Contestants may practice individually on stage at the Pre-Event Stage Practice on Wednesday, July 3 between the hours of 9am and 6pm and/or on day of event from 9am – 10am.

Contestants of all ages may bring a prop to use on stage, but props are not required.

For the 3-5 years of age Division, contestants will have a microphone located at the mark as they approach the front of the stage to pose. At this mark, they may announce their first name and age. This is not required.

Parents on Stage: One parent is allowed on stage to help their child in the walking through 2 years of age division only.

Judging: Judges will be looking at personality, stage presence and confidence. In all cases, the Judges' decisions will be final. In order to respect the integrity of the pageant, score sheets will not be given to the contestants or family members. The judges should not be approached by contestants, friends, or family members before, during, or after the pageant. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated.

Dressing Rooms: A waiting room and restrooms will be available for use by contestants for dressing, etc.

Conduct: Good conduct and sportsmanship is expected at all times during the pageant. Bad sportsmanship from a contestant, family member, or friend will result in disqualification of the contestant and forfeiture of awards. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated. No refunds will be given.

Awards: Trophies will be given to all participants. Grand Trophies will be presented to contestants awarded title of Little Miss & Mr. Firecracker in each age group, for a total of four Grand Trophies to be given.

Admission: It is free to watch the pageant. The Pageant is a part of the Firecracker Festival – a fun day for the entire family, so plan to stay and play!
