

## *Elements of Life*

- **Location:** 506 Art on Main St.
- **Artist:** Ricardo Paniagua (@ricardo\_paniagua)
- **Description:** Geometric totem sculpture
- **Representation/Story:** The work features a 14-foot steel sculpture, reaching for the sky and cascading down in geometric patterns of three prominent colors. The piece is intended to enrich the civic landscape by balancing the historic locale with strong lines and bold colors to reinvigorate the established space. The geometric design compels, challenges and educates residents and visitors.
- **Installation date:** November 2018



- **Description:** Residents added the accent color to painted bottles that were upcycled by the City, and 12 Garland artists used the bottles to create a Community Sculpture Garden.

- **Description:** Pizza wings mural, also referred to as #MEwings

# Black and White Murals



- **Location:** 717 Main St.  
(west side of Doc's Bail Bonds)
- **Artist:** Richard McNeil
- **Description:** Black and white murals
- **Representation/Story:**
  - Savior of the World: Welcoming ALL to Garland
  - Public train that used to run in Downtown Garland
  - Tribute to astronauts who lost their lives
  - Perspective of old Downtown Garland from Main Street
- **Installation date:** First piece of series installed in 1994

- **Description:** Window pet mural illustrating the “paws-itive” impact of pet adoption
- **Installation date:** March 2015

- **Description:** Mural of dogs hanging out in Downtown Garland
- **Installation date:** September 2016

- **Location:** 1019 Austin St.  
(front/south side of Fire Station #1)
- **Artist:** Nyal Stromberg
- **Description:** Bronze sculpture of fireman; Garland Fire Department's 9/11 tribute
- **Installation date:** Early to mid-2000s

- **Location:** 300 N. Fifth St.  
(Granville Arts Center; The Atrium)
- **Artist:** Barvo Walker
- **Description:** Bronze sculpture celebrating dance, music, theatre and the visual arts; Expresses the Garland Cultural Arts Commission's vision of a diverse community in celebration of dance, music, theatre and the visual arts
- **Installation date:** September 2018

- **Description:** Spray paint graffiti-style mural
- **Installation date:** July 2017
