

2019-2020 WCFA Lil' Jr. Queen and Jr. Queen Contest

Rules

- 1) Must be a female (born a female) contestant in grades third thru fifth for Lil' Jr. Queen and grades sixth thru eight for Jr. Queen.
- 2) A contestant must be an active member of 4-H and/or Jr. FFA, and have an entry pertaining to one of these clubs in the Walker County Fair, be academically eligible to participate and be passing all classes with a 70 or higher on contest day, as well as the day of crowning. Contestants must present the Jr. Queen Chairman with grade verification on the day of contest and day of crowning.
- 3) A contestant must be willing to represent the Walker County Fair Association at assigned duties (Chairman will inform duties). The candidates chosen will be under the guidance of the committee throughout her reigning year and must be willing to abide by the guidelines set forth by the WCFA committee. If assigned duties are not fulfilled, the winner will relinquish the title.
- 4) Contestants must have their parents or guardian's written consent to enter the contest.
- 5) Contestants will be required to participate in and furnish their own vehicles for the Walker County Fair Association parade.
- 6) Contestants will be judged in five categories: Hand written essay (25%), Interview (30%), Appearance (10%), Talent (15%), Stage Presence (20%).
- 7) Previous Walker County Fair Lil & Jr. Queens are not eligible to enter the contest in their division.
- 8) A non-refundable entry fee of \$30.00 for each contestant must be submitted with the entry form and handwritten essay (topic will be chosen by the Jr. Queen Committee) on or before February 1st

of the current contest year. All entries are due and must be received by the committee by 7:00 p.m. February 1st.

- 9) All contestants will be required to attend scheduled meetings/events, and rehearsals set forth in the contest calendar.
- 10) All contestants will be required to obtain one \$200.00 sponsorship for the Lil' Jr. Queen/Jr. Queen Contest. Sponsorship can be one business/individual or several businesses/individuals to equal the \$200.00 sponsorship. Contestants are required to submit their sponsorship(s) by the first Friday of March of the current contest year.
- 11) There will be one Lil' Jr and a Lil' Jr. Runner-up awarded along with one Jr. Queen and a Jr. Queen Runner-up awarded each contest year.
- 12) Hand written thank you letters will be written from all contestants of the Lil' Jr. and Jr. Queen contest. A committee member(s) will be present to oversee this action. Committee Chairman will mail.
- 13) On the day of contest, one outfit will be allowed with the exception of the talent entry. The Chairman/committee will inform contestants of their attire prior to the contest.
- 14) Contestants are responsible for their own hair and makeup. Only one parent/legal guardian may assist.
