

## WCFA Prince and Princess Contestant Information

### Parade:

**When:** Sign-in **6:30pm**, Thursday, March 21, 2019 - parade begins at 7:00pm

**Where:** 19<sup>th</sup> Street

**What to wear:** White shirt

Keep the weather in mind and dress appropriately

(**Don't** wear your contest clothes)

T-shirts will be handed out when you sign-in.

**What to bring:** CANDY (lots) to throw (many children run out quickly)

**Be prepared:** To sit flat during the ride for safety.

**Parents please:** Provide cell phone # for emergencies, know in advance who will be picking up your child. Will have a sign in and sign out sheet.

**\*\*\*Please, no crowns on the float!**

**Pick-up:** We will meet at the Sam Houston Funeral home. We ask that ALL CHILDREN are picked up from that location.. last year the parade route changed and we had parents grabbing kids off of the trailer without properly signing said child out. We do this for the safety of your child. Thank you for understanding!

**For safety:** Each child needs to be signed out by the appropriate adult.

**\*\*Please discuss being courteous, careful, and respectful with your child before the parade in order for everyone to enjoy themselves and have fun safely.\*\***

### Contest:

**When:** Boys and younger girls **MUST** Sign-in by **5:45pm**, Friday, March 22, 2019.

Contest begins at **6:00pm**

**Older girls only may sign in by 6:45 pm**

If you did not participate in the parade, your t-shirt will be available for pick-up at the sign-in table

**Where:** Main Building of Walker County Fairgrounds

**Contest Order:** Pre-K & Kindergarten Girls

- Pre-K and Kinder Girls report to chairs near stage by **5:55**, please.
- Help will be available to assist with seating
- Contestants need to leave their contestant # on at all times, please.
- **Please return these numbers at the conclusion of the contest.**
- **Please, crowns should only be worn by contest winners, during the contest and the week of the fair.**
- Other contestants will sit with their parents until their contest begins.
- Contestants will draw for only one slip of paper. Each slip will contain questions for the contestant to answer (2 questions from the list we have provided and 1 random question) The emcee will

read the questions one at a time for the child to answer. Each contestant will be asked the same amount of questions.

- This year we will **NOT** break briefly between contest groups.
- The prince contest will begin immediately after the younger girls, and younger girls will remain seated by the stage during the prince contest.
- **We are changing the awards format this year; please leave your child with us until the conclusion of our awards ceremony.**
- Contestants will compete in random order, and will also receive their goodie bags/awards in random order. Contestants **are not** revealed in point score order of any kind, except the top four places.
- Additional awards will be presented to third, second, first runners up and the Prince/Princess.

We will hold a brief parent meeting to go over everything for the upcoming week. **Rosette winners should be prepared to attend opening ceremonies Saturday morning.**

*\*Family and friends are welcome to video and take photographs during and after the contest on stage. Please remember to be courteous to others who would like to take photos as well. We again ask that the audience noise level be kept to a minimum during the contest. From the first to the last, each child deserves the chance to be heard and seen on stage.*
