

Walker County Fair Association Prince and Princess Contest Rules

1. Candidates must be residents of or attend school in Walker County.
2. The contest will have 3 categories of candidates:
 - Princess - Girls in Pre-K (age 4 by September 1 of current school year), and Kindergarten
 - Princess - Girls in 1st Grade (age 6 by September 1 of current school year), and 2nd Grade
 - Prince - Boys in Pre-K (age 4 by September 1 of current school year), thru 2nd GradeThe committee retains the right to combine the categories in the event of an insufficient number of entries in a category.
3. Past winners are not eligible to re-compete in the same category.
4. Candidates will be required to pay a-\$30.00 entry fee
5. Candidates will be judged on personality, poise, and attire.
6. Awards will be given to the winners, first, second and third runners-up in each category. The winners will be announced on the night of the contest.
7. Winners must be willing to represent the WCFA at assigned duties during the spring fair activities. All winners, first, second & third runners-up are required to attend the WCFA opening ceremonies on Saturday afternoon. These are also the only candidates eligible to ride in the Rodeo Grand Entry.
8. Judges will be selected from outside of Walker County.
9. On-site registration will be held on Tuesday during the third week in February at the Walker County Fair Grounds. Forms may also be turned into the fair rental office during regular business hours beginning February 1st through the last Friday of February.
