

Walker County Fair Junior Clothing Division Rules

ALL ENTRANTS MUST HAVE SIGNED A LETTER OF INTENT ON OR BEFORE THE LAST FRIDAY IN OCTOBER AND PARTICIPATED IN AT LEAST TWO CONTENT RELATED ACTIVITIES.

1. Junior clothing division is open to Walker County youth who are members of FCCLA or 4-H clothing project area and are in the 3rd-12th grade.
2. Student will enter according to grade level as follows: 3rd grade – 5th grade, 6th grade – 8th grade, 9th grade – 12th grade as of September 1.
3. All entries must have been constructed within the last calendar year.
4. Contestants for showmanship award may only model one entry.
5. Entry fee is listed in WCFA General Rules. Fee is due with the completed entry form by the date listed in the General Rules.
6. Entries are due at Fabric Carousel, the Wednesday before the opening day of the Fair (March 20th, 2019) by 5:00 p.m. Entries must be on hangers and protected by a plastic bag. Attach name, age and FCCLA/4-H for identification. Also include pattern envelope, guide sheet and fabric sample.
7. Workmanship judging is not open to the public. Showmanship judging will be at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday (March 26th, 2019), the week of the Fair. The Style Show and Awards Ceremony will be the same afternoon after judging. (3:30PM)
8. Awards: Showmanship and Workmanship awards will be given in each group. Overall Grand Champion will be selected in both areas. The individual with the highest total combined score for one garment will receive a special high point award.
9. All garments will stay on display at the Walker County Fairgrounds through the closing of the Fair. Arrangements will be made as to when to pick up garments.
10. Wearable art includes decorated shirts, tee shirts, sweatshirts, vests and other miscellaneous items. THESE ITEMS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE SHOWMANSHIP AWARD, BUT MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE STYLE SHOW.
